ATTENTION SCHREIBER CURLERS

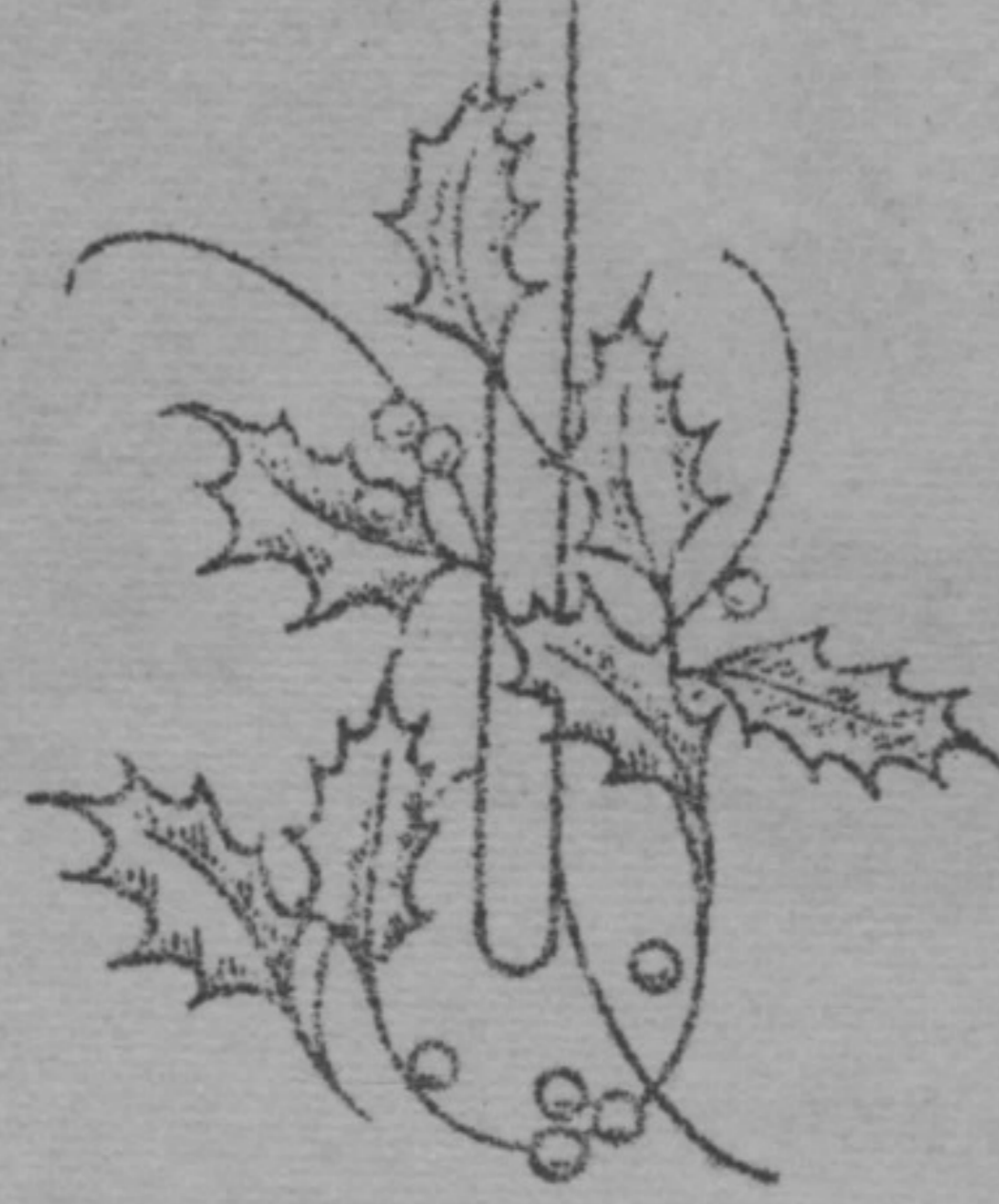

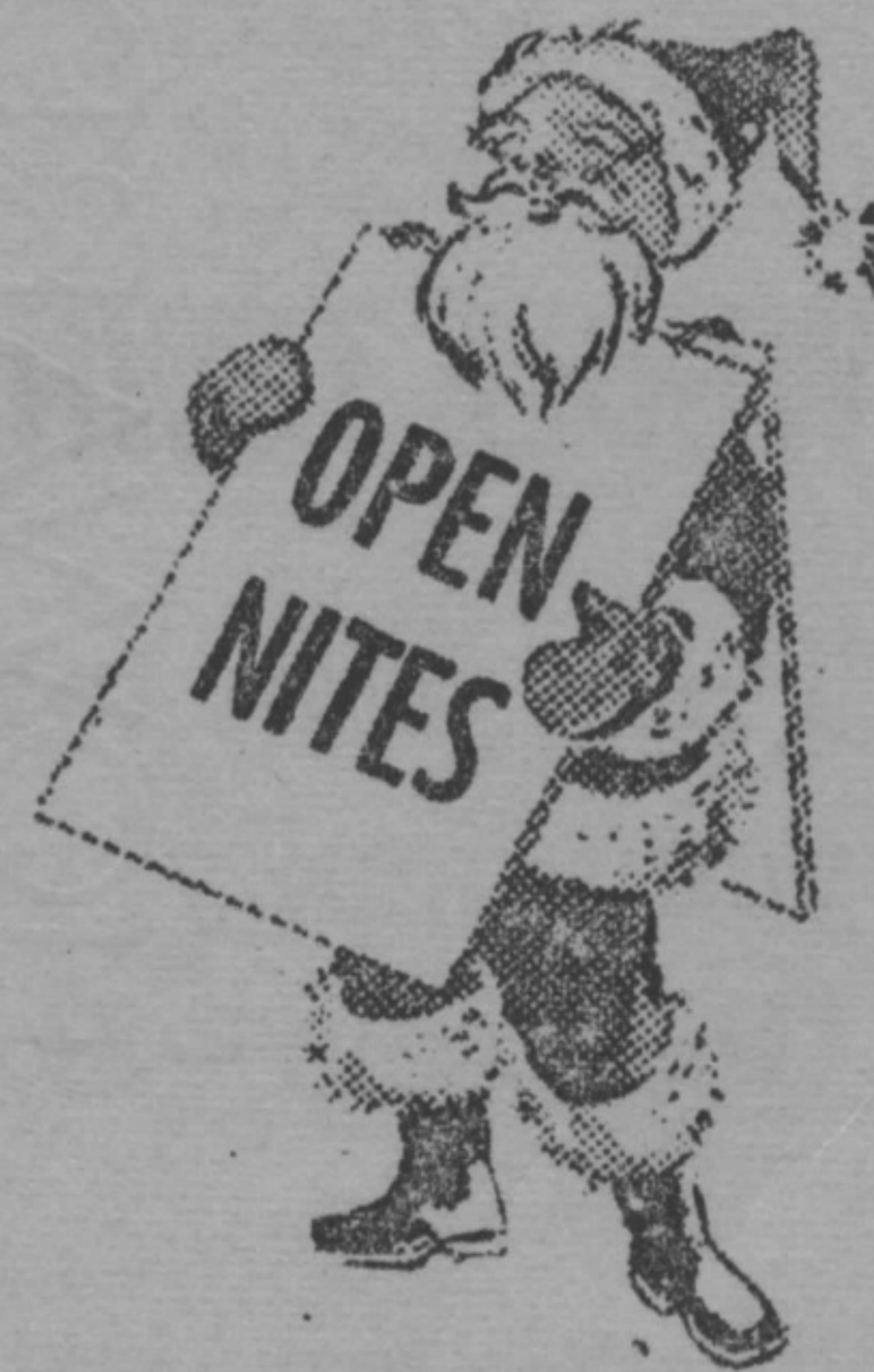
