WATER SAFE INSTRUCTORS' COURSE AT FT. WILLIAM

A Red Cross Swimming and Water Safety Instructors' Course will be held on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, April 3, 4, 5, 6, using the Y.M.C.A. Pool and the Fort William Red Cross Centre.

The Course is sponsored by the Water Safety Service Branch of the Canadian Red Cross Society, Ontario Division, in co-operation with the Fort William and Port Arthur Red Cross Branches and the Community Programmes Branch of the Ontario Department of Education.

Applications from any community conducting or planning to conduct a Swimming and Water Safety programme will be welcomed. Applicants should be 18 years of age and hold a Royal Life Saving Bronze Medallion or equivalent award.

Applicants who are approved for the Course will be notified of detailed arrangements prior to the Course. Applications must be returned by March 17.

The individual or sponsoring group is responsible for travel, room and board of the applicants. There is no fee for the course. Application forms may be obtained from the Recreation Director, Red Cross Water Safety Chairman or the Community Programmes Branch, 400 Catherine Street, Fort William, Ontario.
