

# ALL THE TIME



All entries will be divided into three age groups and prizes awarded for each group.

Prize awards are as follows: Group #1 - all entries up to and including 8 years old - 1st prize-Combination Head Light and Horn, 2nd prize -Double Kick Stands, 3rd prize - Mud Guard Flaps. Group #2 - all entries between the ages of 8 years and 12 years old - 1st prize - Combination Head Light and Horn, 2nd prize -Plastic Carrier, 3rd prize - Mud Guard Flaps. Group #3 - all entries over 12
