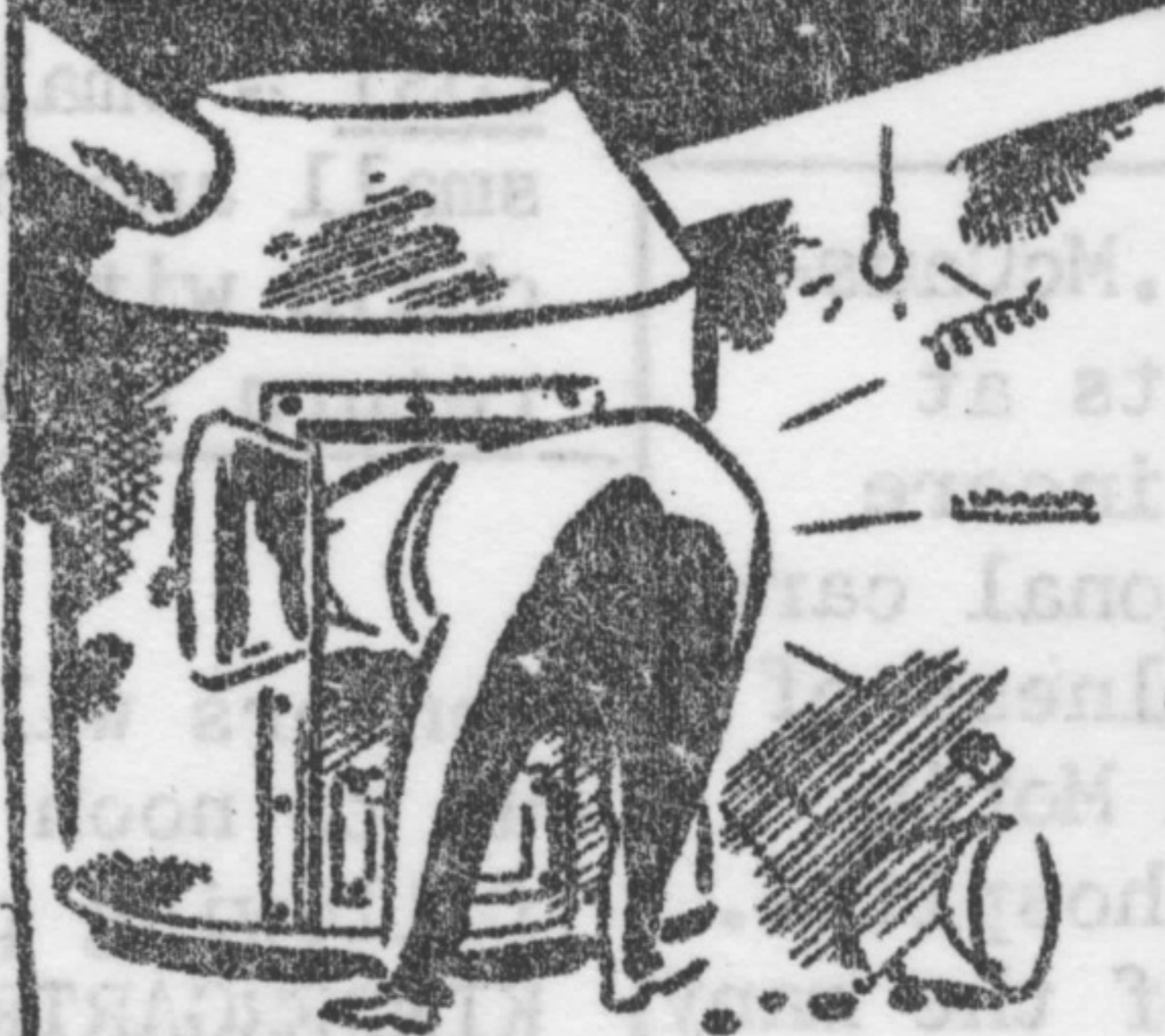
L. CHATEAUVERT ADDRESSES THE SCHREIBER CHAMBER OF COMMERCE

An executive meeting of the Schreiber District Chamber of Commerce was held on June 23rd in the office of President Bob Spadoni.

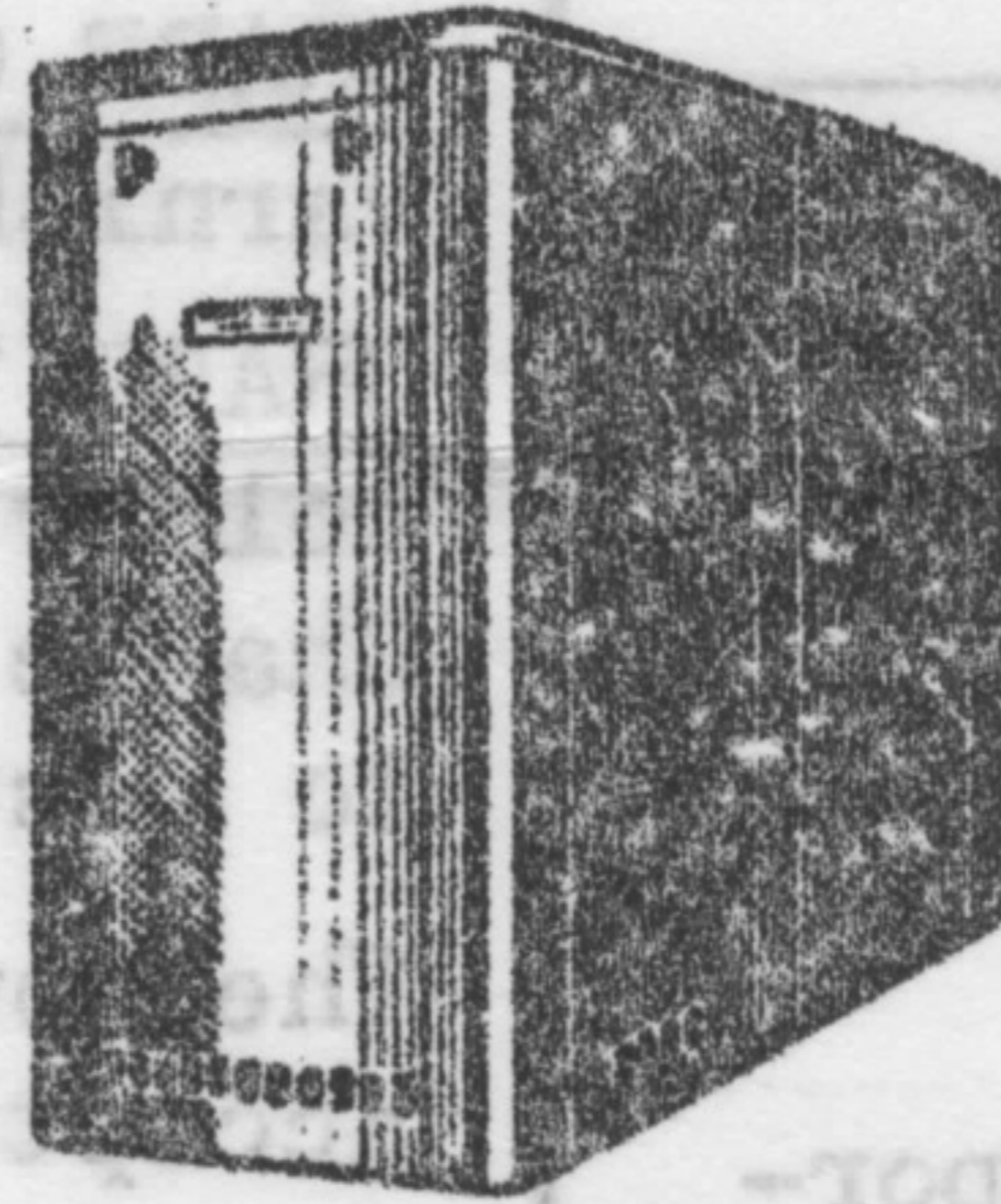
