Branch sends out pictures to all Chambers of Commerce--the Information Branch which is responsible for the distribution of literature. (There are fourteen reception centres in Ontario where literature on our area may be sent). The Archaeological and Historical Branch, which is responsible for placement of plaques, et cetera -- the Theatre Branch -- responsible for censoring all films -- the Development Branch, with thirteen offices across Ontario -- responsible for inspection of Motels etc., plus development and increase of facilities throughout the Province.

In reply to an inquiry by Mr. Spadoni regarding opening up a road into the Duck Lake Area, it was recommended that the District member of Parliament be contacted. This was done and the subject will be brought before the Recreational Planning Committee who are responsible for zoning areas. Mr. Spadoni is also contacting the Mine Owners in regard to the project.
