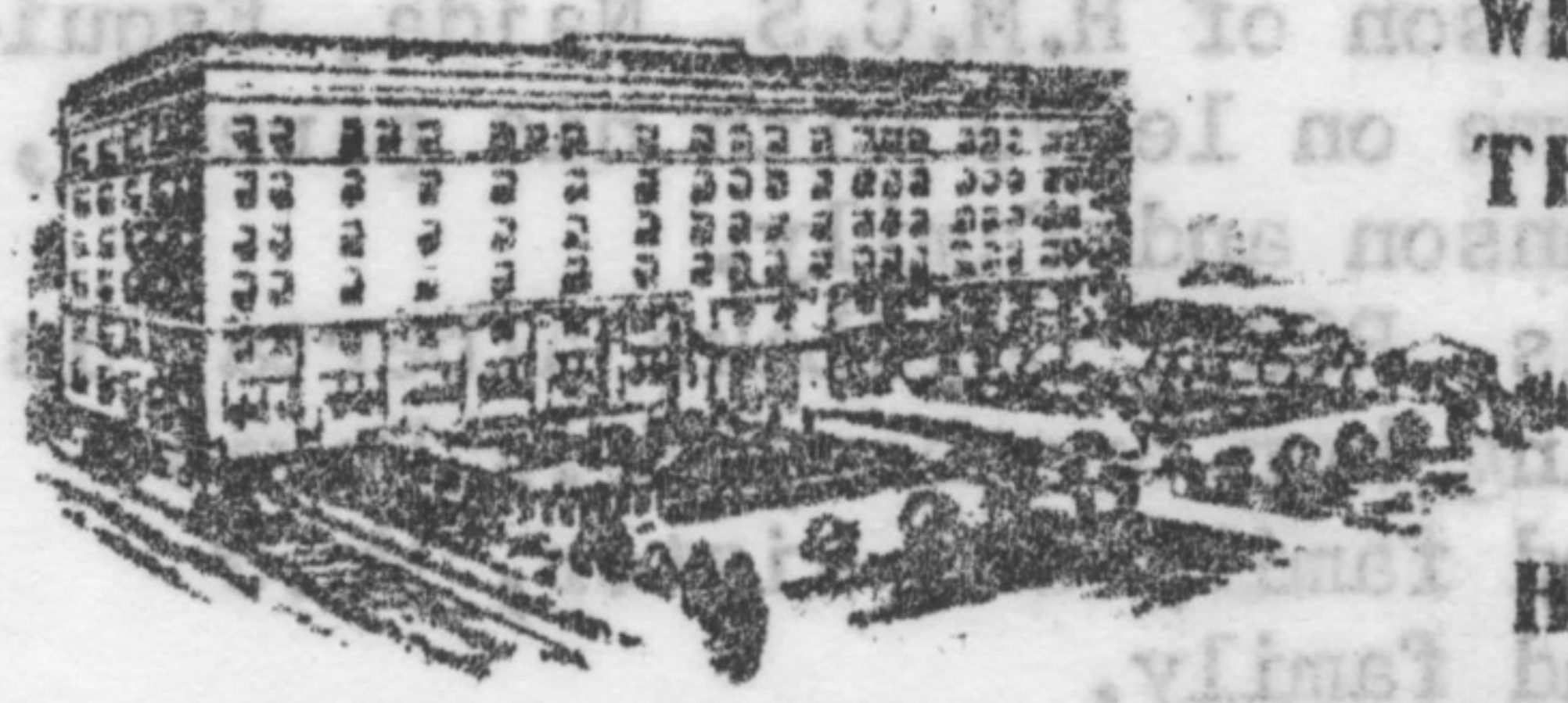
All women whose boys play minor hockey can show their interest in their son's activities and also give encouragement to the few who have worked on the Auxiliary so faithfully, by attending this meeting.

All hunters should be familiar with Section 66 (a) of the Game and Fisheries Act which reads as follows: "Every person is guilty of the offence of hunting carelessly who, being in possession of a fire-arm or air gun for the purpose of hunting, discharges or causes to be discharged or handles such fire-arm or air gun without due care and attention or without reasonable consideration for persons or property and is liable to a fine of not more than \$500.00 or to imprisonment for a term of nor more than six months, or to both".
