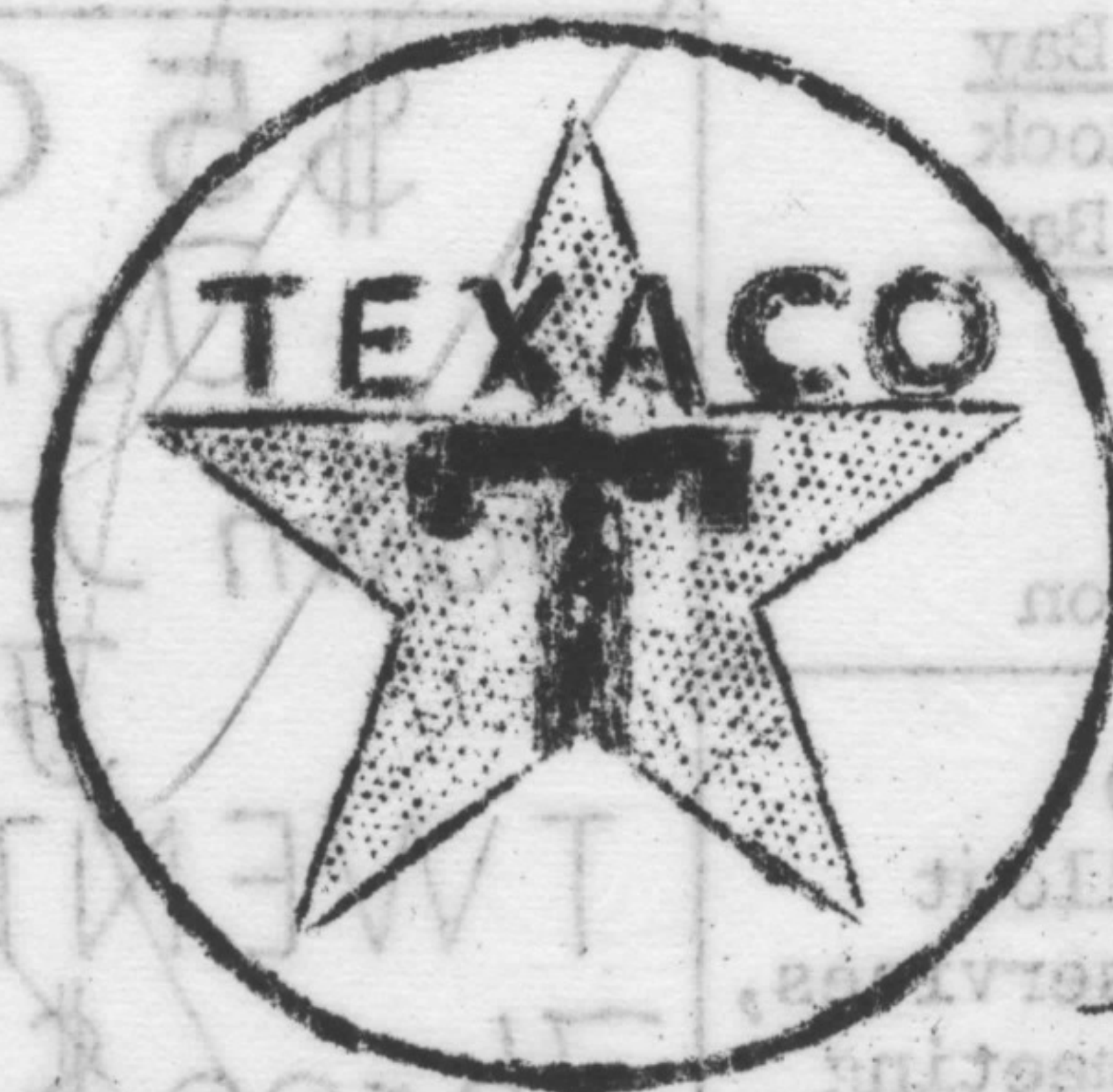
Joan Lundberg visited with her parents, Mr. & Mrs. S. Lundberg for a few days last week prior to her departure Wednesday for Toronto via TCA.
