transients received aid from the Transient's Fund. Reeve Heenan highly commended the report.

The December Fire Report showed only one small fire to mar a near-perfect record for the month. A resume of Fire Dept. activities were listed followed by a request to commence replacement of hose as stipulated in the Fire Marshall's Act.

December accounts for the Public Library, Hydro, Township and Recreation were read and approved for payment.

Council passed a motion to present former Council members with Township Crests.

On a recommendation by Reeve Heenan, Councillor Evans-Smith, who had polled the highest number of votes in the last election, was appointed Deputy Reeve.

Mr. Jack Phillips was re-appointed to the Recreation Association for a 3 year term to Dec. 31, 1964. Official approval was given to appointment of Mrs. G. Black and Mr. W. Farrell whose term of office expires Dec. 31, 1963. Other Board members are M. Campbell until 1963 and J. Kennedy until 1962.

Library Board appointments are: Mr. W.F. Colborne, Mrs. S. Hodgkiss, Mrs. D. Evans-Smith, Mrs. C. Knauff and Mr. J. Brooks.

Reeve Heenan requested investigation into short-term investment of any surplus from July 1 to December 31 and a report from Mr. W. Neish on progress of the Utilities Bldg. was heard. A motion was passed to have Acting Fire Chief R. Hofland and Mill Fire Chief G. Maitland alternate weekends of duty, both serving for said period, a dual role for the Mill and Town.

Complaints concerning dogs at large in the townsite have been received and notice will be posted reiterating the law and penalties.
