Dear Sir,

As a graduate of Schreiber Continuation School and as one still involved in education, perhaps I may be permitted to comment on the problems involved in the proposals for high school construction in the Schreiber-Terrace Bay area.

Let me say at once that I am proud to be among the graduates which S.C.S. has produced. Taken all in all, I would venture to say that the number of its graduates who have gone on to higher learning or who have succeeded well in business compares favourably with any school of its size in the Province.

At the same time, it is somewhat sobering to contemplate how many more graduates there would have been had the young people of Schreiber had better facilities. The proposals for a district high school at Terrace Bay offer these facilities. In addition to the commercial and technical training that could be provided in a composite school, a larger student body makes possible a more varied academic program, a more adequately equipped building and, all else being equal, a more attractive academic environment that will attract and hold the calibre of teacher that the two communities deserve.

The proposals for a technical and vocational wing (if such, indeed, are contemplated) offer a distinct economic advantage. The grants for construction and equipment of such a school as provided by the Federal and Provincial governments under the Technical Assistance Act will pay all costs except that of land. It would appear that there are two significant qualifications to the financial assistance. One is that such a school must have an enrolment of 400 within (Cont'd P. 8)
