



HOUSEHOLD HINTS Squeaking Floors

To stop the annoying squeaks caused by two floor boards rubbing against each other, spray some powdered graphite or sprinkle some talcum powder between the offending boards at the friction spot. The graphite or talcum will work its way between the loose boards and act as a lubricant in preventing further squeaks.
