 (e) Publicity Manager - (f) Finance Chairman plus a two man Committee

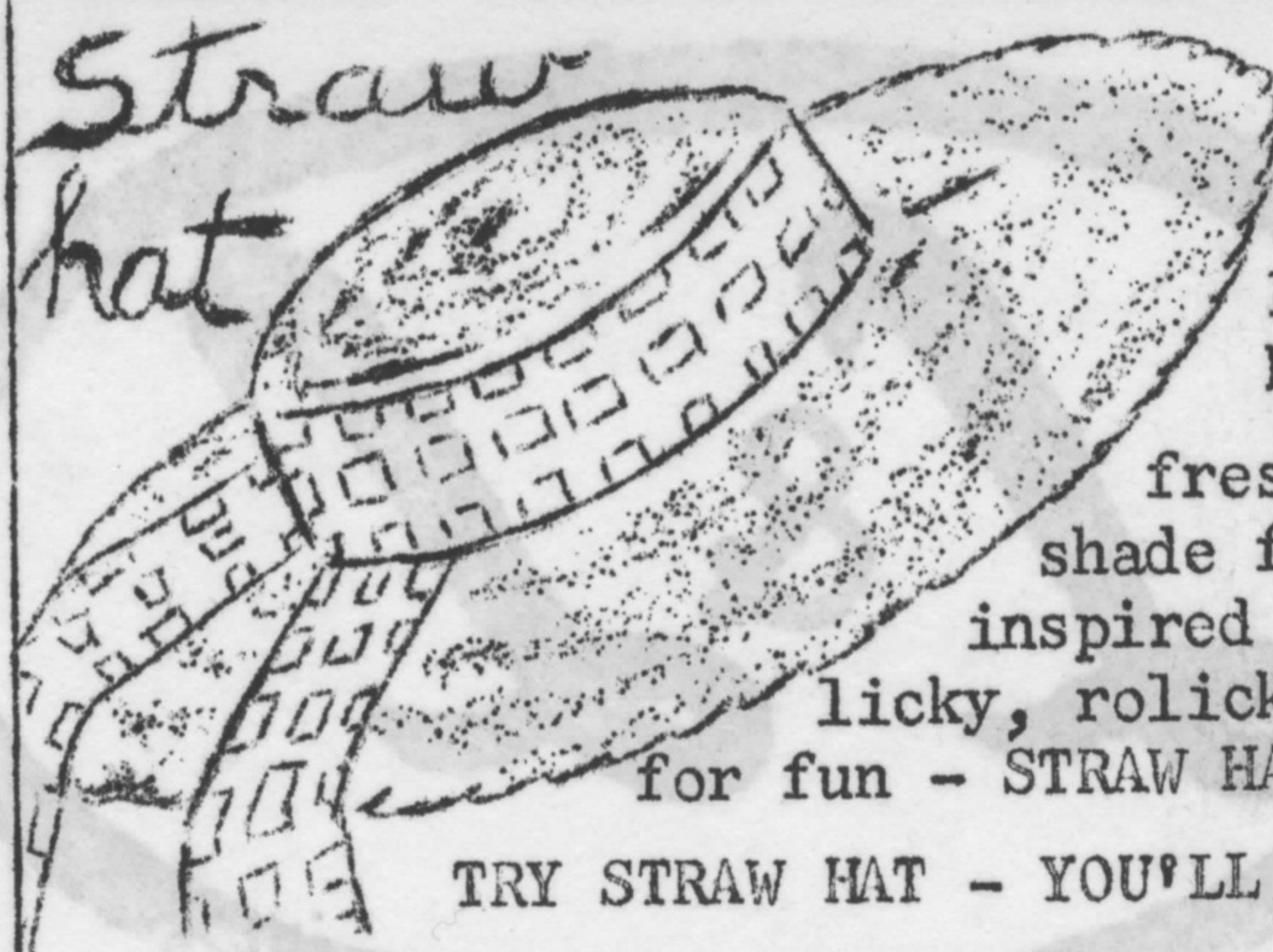
