MINOR BASEBALL NEWS

After two weeks of operation, all 4 Minor Baseball Leagues are going full blast, after a slow start because of cool weather. Parents and players should note that the following is the schedule for Minor teams:

- INTERNATIONAL LEAGUE** - 6 and 7 year olds - play at the Separate School diamond every Tuesday and Thursday at 4:30 P.M.
- AMERICAN LEAGUE** - 8 and 9 yr. olds - play at the Separate School diamond every Monday, Wednesday and Friday at 4:30 P.M.
- NATIONAL LEAGUE** - 10 to 12 year olds - play at the Public School diamond every Monday, Wednesday and Friday at 4:30 P.M.
- BANTAM LEAGUE** - 13 to 16 yr. olds - play at the Public School diamond every Tuesday and Thursday at 4:00 P.M.

All leagues will be active through till the end of June, and playoffs will take place in the first two weeks in July. After that time, all-star teams will be formed in the Bantam League groups, for competition against outside teams.

Play in the International League is primarily devoted to instruction in catching, throwing and pitching. American Leaguers are beginning to learn the skills of the game, and play in regular Leagues under modified rules. Players in the International and Bantam Leagues play under regular rules.
