

### SWIMMING PROGRAMME

Children may register with the lifeguard at the Dam any day of the week. The area is supervised from 10 a.m. until 6 p.m. Monday through Saturday, and from 1 p.m. to 6 p.m. on Sunday. All swimming classes are held in the afternoons, with bus service being provided from the Recreation Centre.

Those who have not yet registered should contact R. Schock, Instructor, at the Dam. Times and days of lessons will be given to the children as they register.

### WADING POOL

The children's wading pool, north of the Arena, is open for use of the small children.

PLEASE NOTE THAT THIS AREA IS FOR USE OF SMALL CHILDREN WHO ARE NON-SWIMMERS. Older children, and those who can swim, have a supervised area provided at the Dam for their use.

The water in the wading pool is changed at least three times weekly, and chemicals are added to the water to ensure purity. However, we must depend on the help of users to keep the area clean. Please abide by the rules laid down on the signs at the wading pool, and see that your child helps to keep the swimming area in the best of condition.
