She has also taken post graduate work in general Education, Nursing School Administration and Vocational Education Administration, in addition to participating in workshops on "Improving Patient Care, and at St. Luke's she had been an instructor. Her experience includes General Duty Nursing, Obstetrical Nursing and working as Head Nurse, a Director of Nursing Service, a Director of in-service Education and an Instructor in schools of Nursing Education.

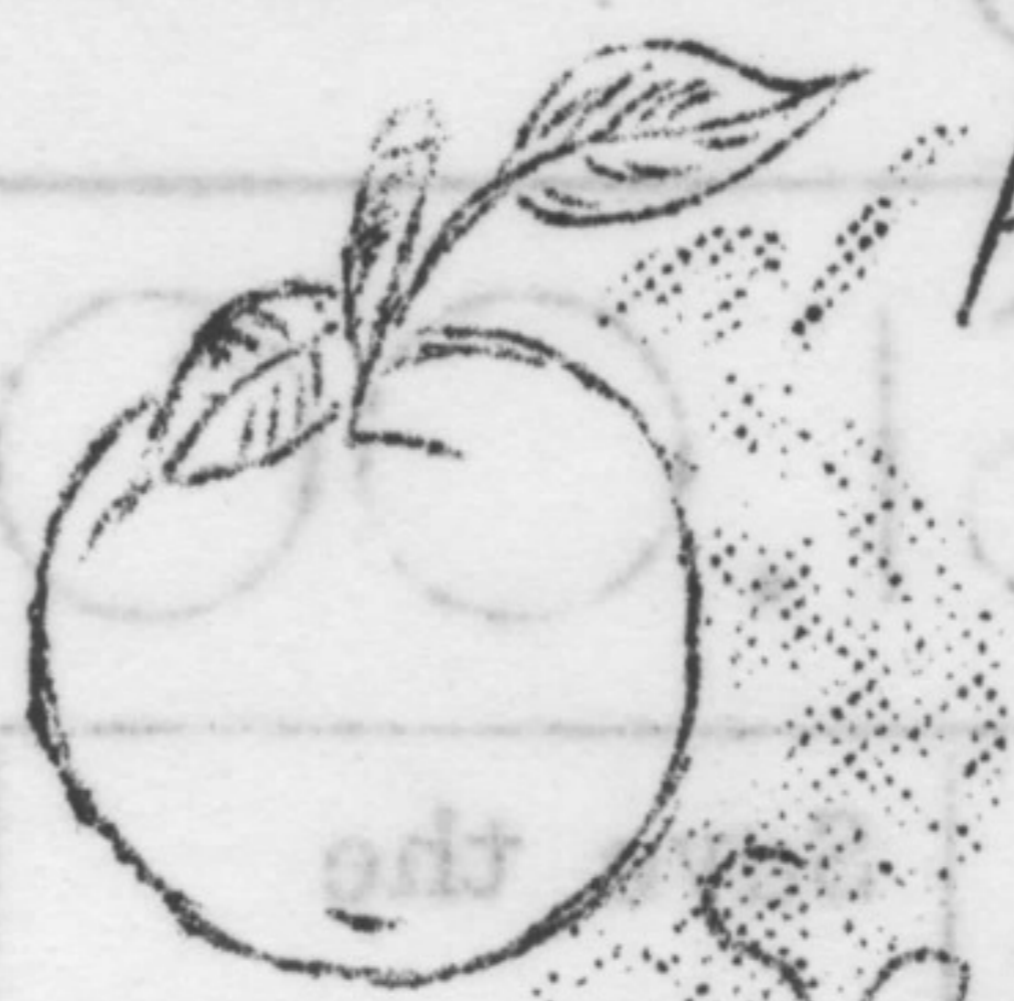
