By-law No.139 prohibiting Hunting, Shooting and Molesting of animals and birds within the limits of the Township of Terrace Bay.

Section I states that "within a radius of two miles of the Post Office Building at Terrace Bay, no person shall hunt, shoot or molest any animal or bird by any means whatsoever, including, but not so as to restrict the generality of the foregoing, through the use of firearms or bow and arrow."

(2) Penalties are provided for any infraction of the above.
