The Society defines a crippled child as one under 19 years whose musculo-skeletal activity is restricted for any reason, such as birth deformities, diseases which produce disability or results of accident injuries and other conditions. Help for these children must be obtained through the family physician applying to the Society or in many cases it is the District Nurse who learns of cases requiring help or treatment and makes application for Society Services. The Society provides assistance in nursing services, treatment centres, camping services, clinics. Miscellaneous services provided through the District Nurse include, through the loan cupboard, wheel chairs, crutches, walkers and special equipment. They arrange for reduced fares for travelling when necessary for patients and escorts. Special holidays are provided for seriously handicapped children not eligible for regular crippled childrens camps. Presently in the Province of Ontario there are - 5 rehabilitation centres (children & adults); 4 crippled children's centres; 13 cerebral palsy treatment centres; 1 orthopaedic school and 5 summer camps. The work is financed by funds received from Easter Seals, bequests, private donations and some government grants.
