Anyone interested in an interview as outlined should inform the Principal immediately.

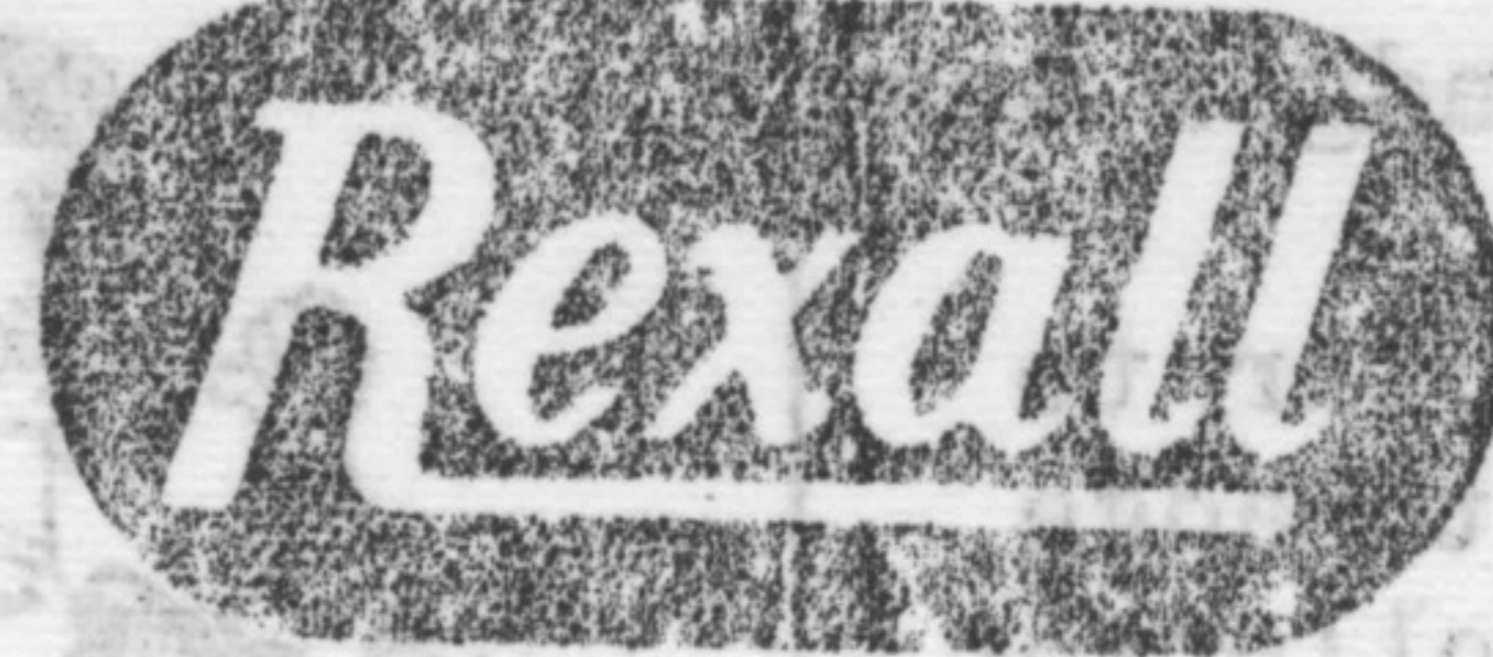

NOTICE RE GRADE XIII

The Terrace Bay High School Board has indefinitely deferred plans to establish a Grade XIII in the Terrace Bay High School. The following consideration among others led the Board to this decision.

1. Completely discouraging advice from
 - (a) Superintendent of Secondary Education -
 - (b) Chairman of the Central Ontario Staff Inspection Team.
 Emphasizing the areas in which we would have difficulty in justifying the decision in favor of a Grade XIII -
 - (a) The difficulty of good instruction to a very small class -
 - (b) The necessity of acquiring for next year at least two staff members with better qualifications and/or more experience.
2. The availability of a Grade XIII within ten miles and the reluctance of your Board to disregard the advice of the senior officials of the Department of Education moved the Board to make this decision.
3. Section 70 of the Secondary Schools Boards of Education Act covers the legal obligation of this Board with reference to fees for students attending Secondary School away from Terrace Bay.
