COUNCIL QUOTES

Reeve J.P. Heenan opened the meeting of Council Wednesday afternoon in the Municipal Offices, calling on Secretary Mr. W.F. Strutt to read the minutes and correspondence.

Correspondence from Texaco with regard to the transfer of their waterline to the Municipality was explained by the Reeve who stated legal documents concerning right of way across private property must be completed first. A letter was sent to Canada Cunnite Company questioning their invoice on equipment necessary to winterize the pool.

Confirmation was sent to Mr. Harry Coe that the week of February 17th to 23rd would be proclaimed Boy Scout Week by Council.

Many items on the Recreation accounts for January were questioned before being passed for payment. Councillor Valiquette recommended a copy of receipts as well as disbursements be made available to council, for the perusal of those not serving on the Recreation Committee.
