POOL CLOSING (Continued from Page 4) re-opened until the chlorine content returns to normal. We usually try to do this at night or during bad weather. However, if weather is bad and we super-chlorinate, then the weather clears, it would mean we would have to delay opening for several hours.

Also, as has been noted, there may be periods of cold weather or rain when it is unhealthy or even dangerous to swim and the pool will be closed for these periods.

THE POOL WILL BE OPEN AS LONG AND AS OFTEN AS IS POSSIBLE. BUT, IF THESE RARE EMERGENCY CLOSINGS SHOULD ARISE, PLEASE BE ASSURED THAT THEY ARE NECESSARY.
