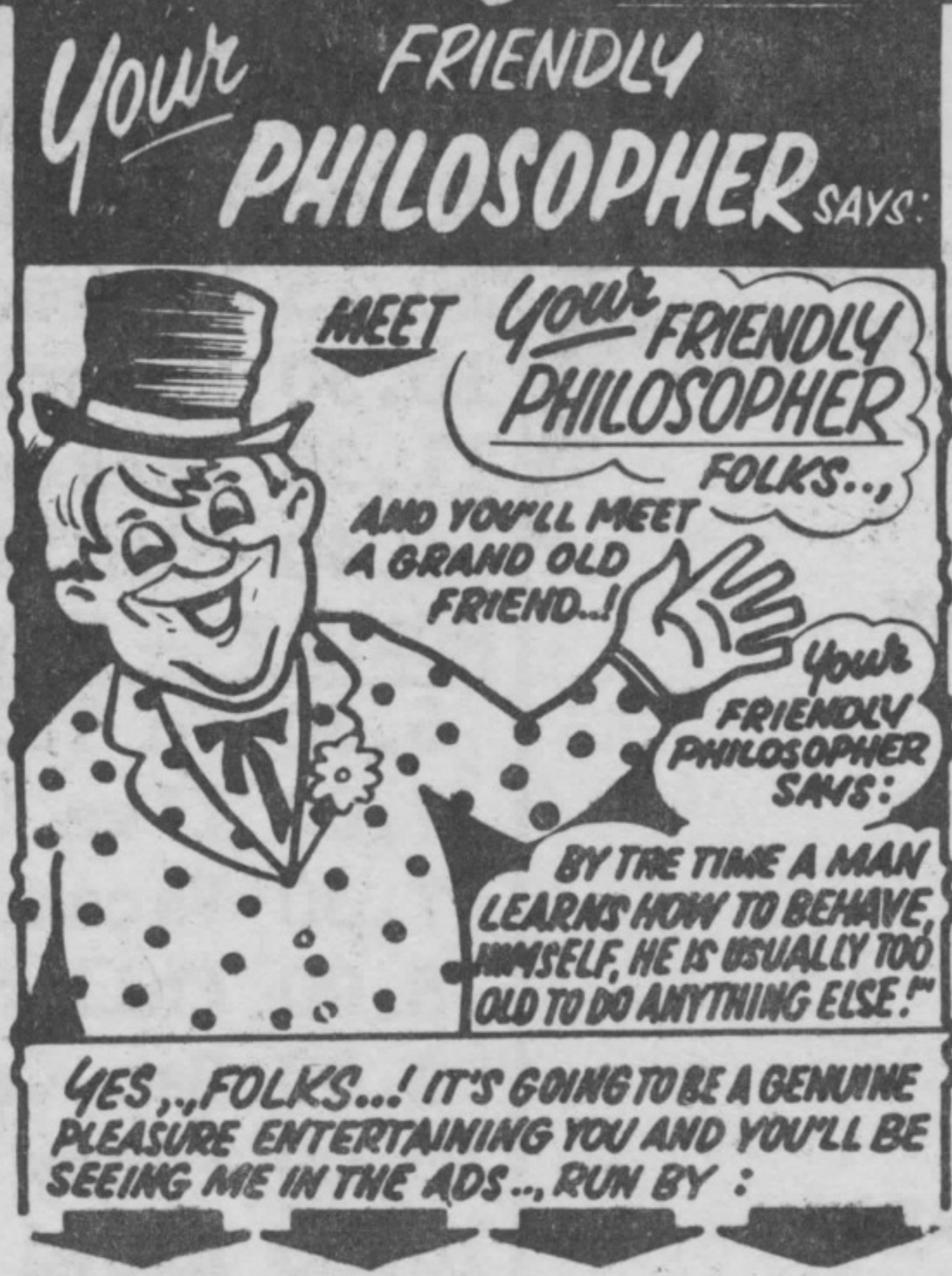
Another bright interlude was provided by children of the Junior Playground as they presented "Working on the Railroad".

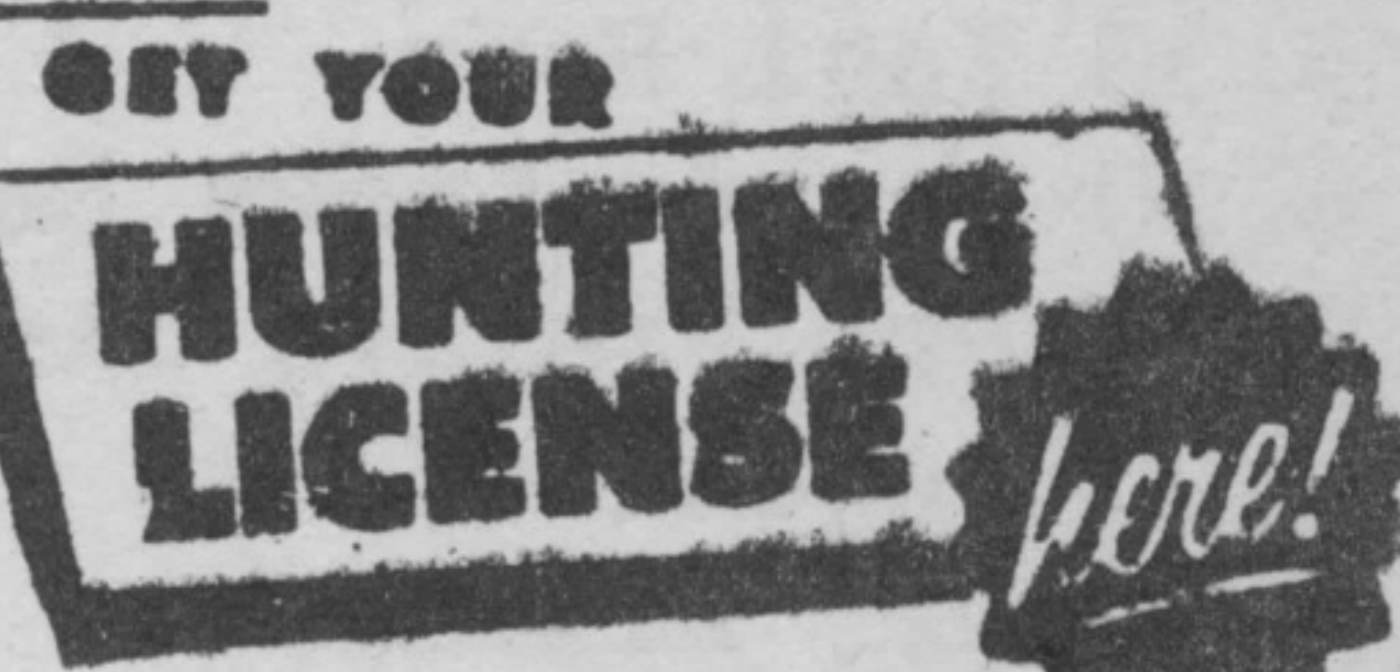
