Life in Terrace Bay is pretty lonely for John. He spends most of his time in the J.P.R. because that's about the only thing there is for a bachelor to do. Some day he plans to take a big holiday in the city where he hopes to find the girl of his dreams to marry, will she be happy to leave the big city to live in Terrace Bay. There are almost no single girls his age here for they have all left to work somewhere else.

The lives and happiness of all these young people are jeopardized - all because employers
