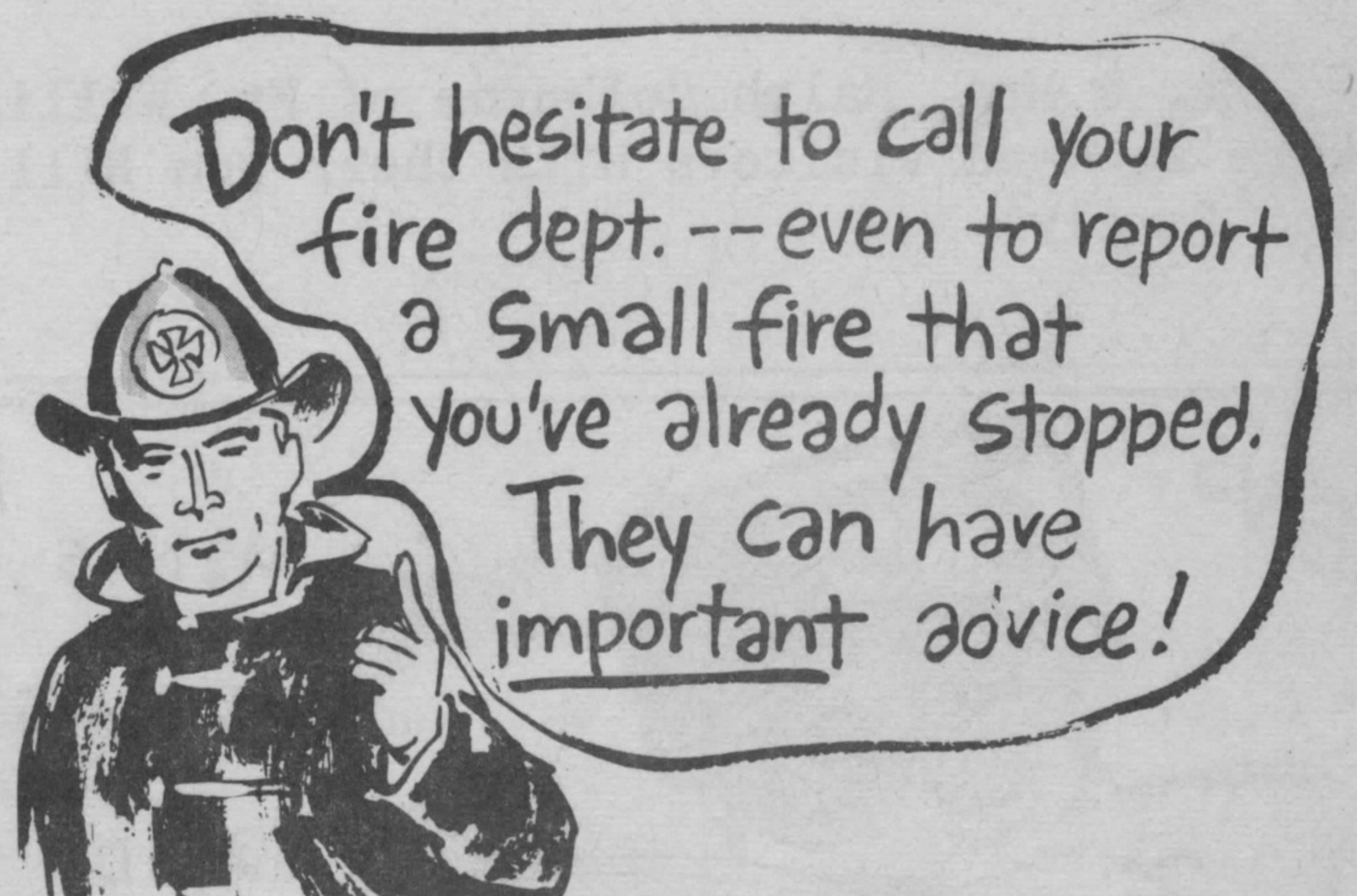
Protect yourself and your clothes and **1) SHUT OFF STOVE.**
