The treasurer's report, for June, July and August, was presented by Mrs. A. O'Keefe.

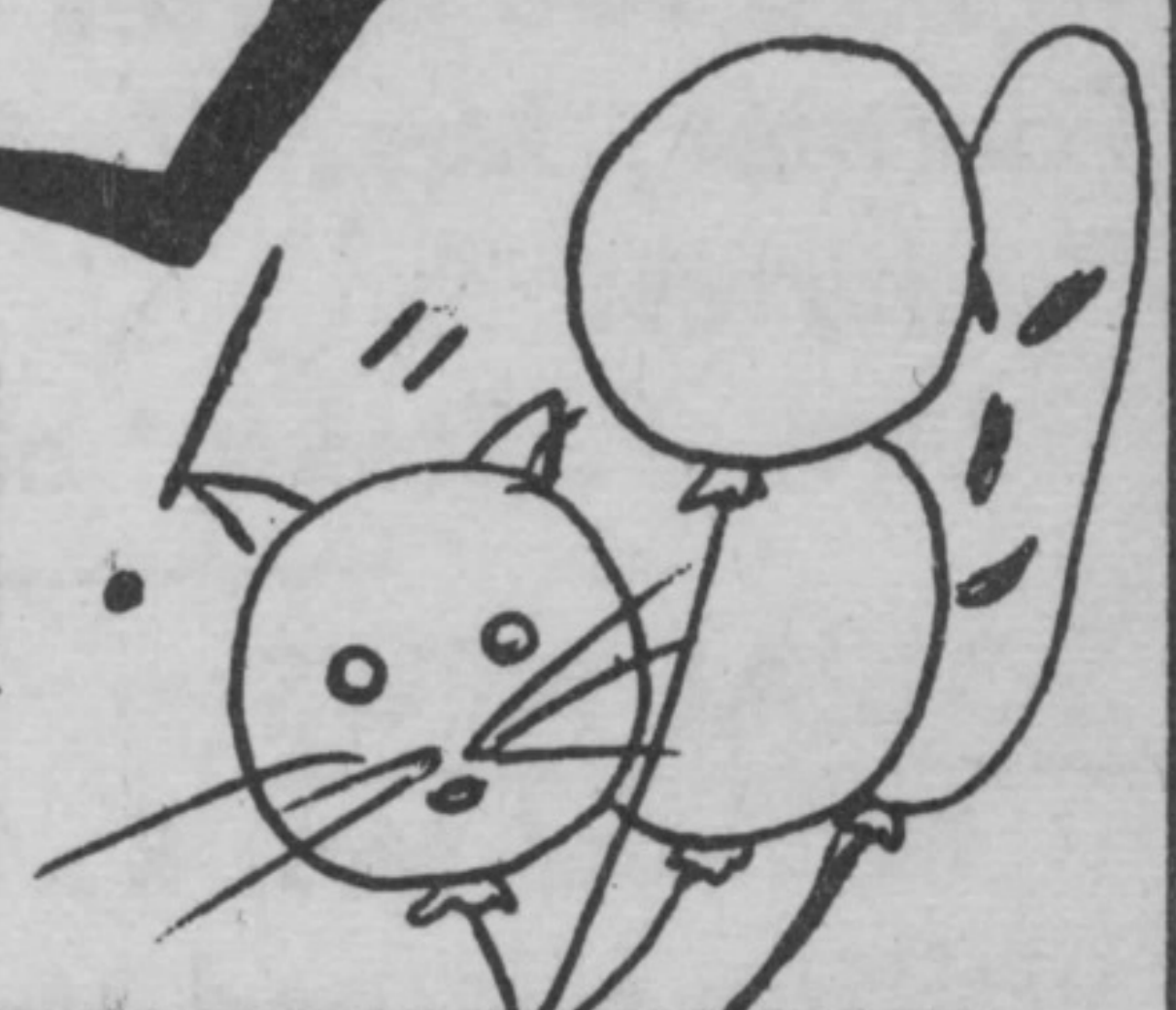
Mrs. S. Kusik, Spiritual Convenor, stated the Discussion Club will resume meetings on September 23rd.
