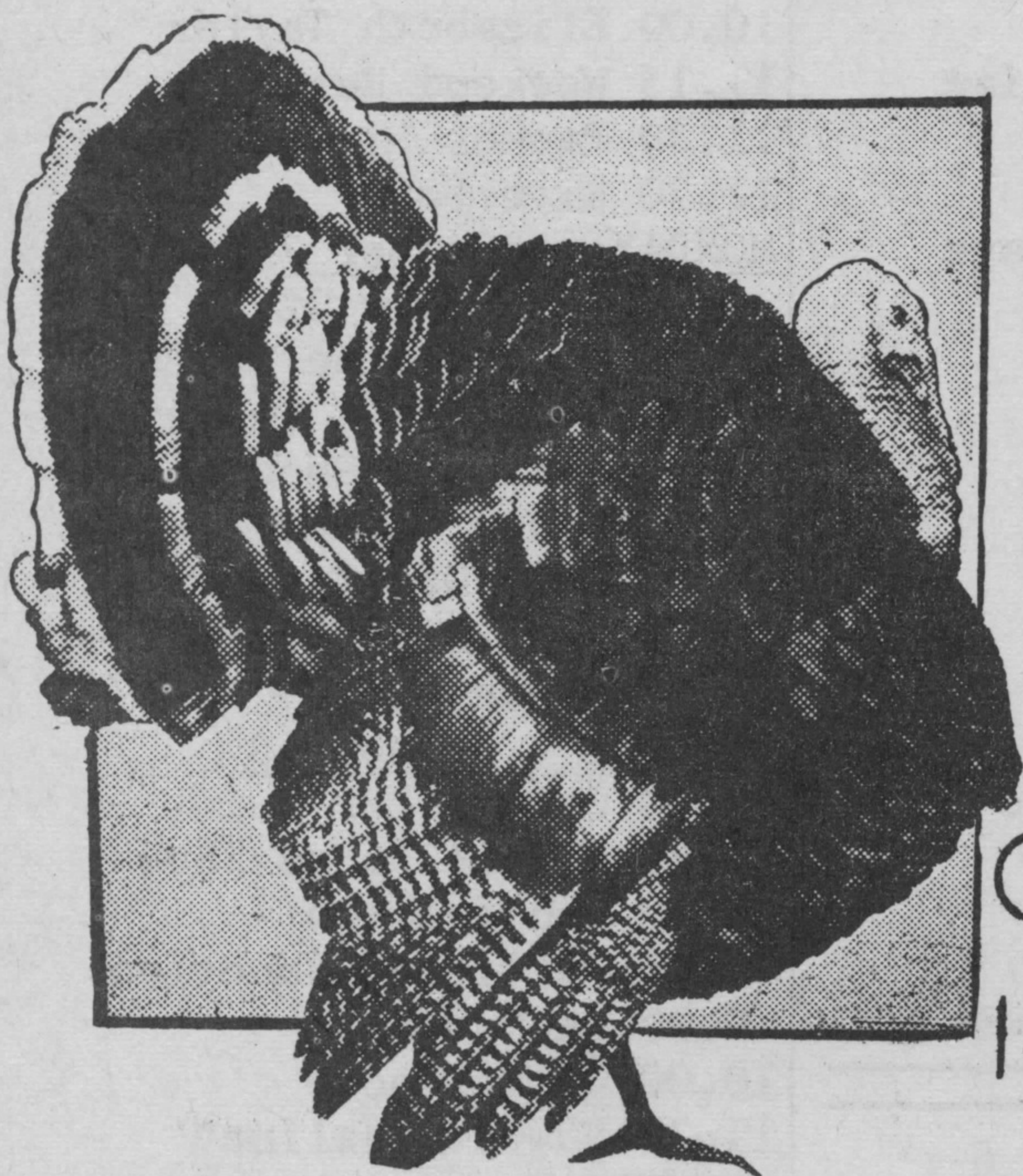

the points taken from my talk were discussed--quotation from Council Quotes, Sept. 26th "News"--
"Reeve Heenan noted that in essence each item had been refuted as they had been questioned verbally by the group." I do not believe that 'questioning' is refuting (refute--to prove to be false or in error) nor, in view of the letter drafted by the group at this meeting, would it appear that they believed that all the issues were refuted.

On the matter of Police Committee meetings, I stand corrected. The fact is that I have not 'attended' any Police Committee meetings since last May.

In the first column of Page 10 of Sept. 26th "News" the last clause of paragraph three says "and not as stated, a decision made prior to council meeting. I have made no such statement."
