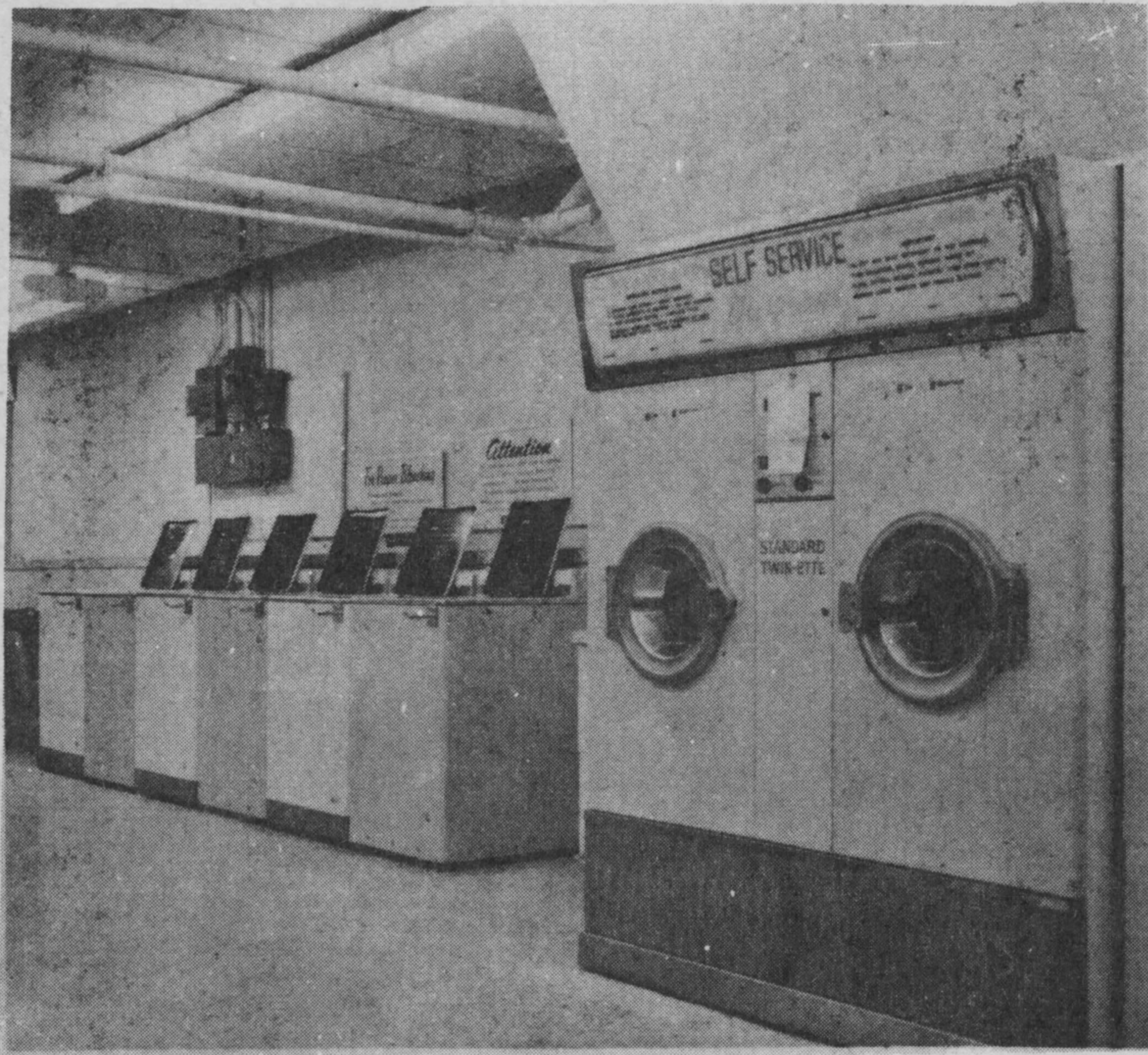
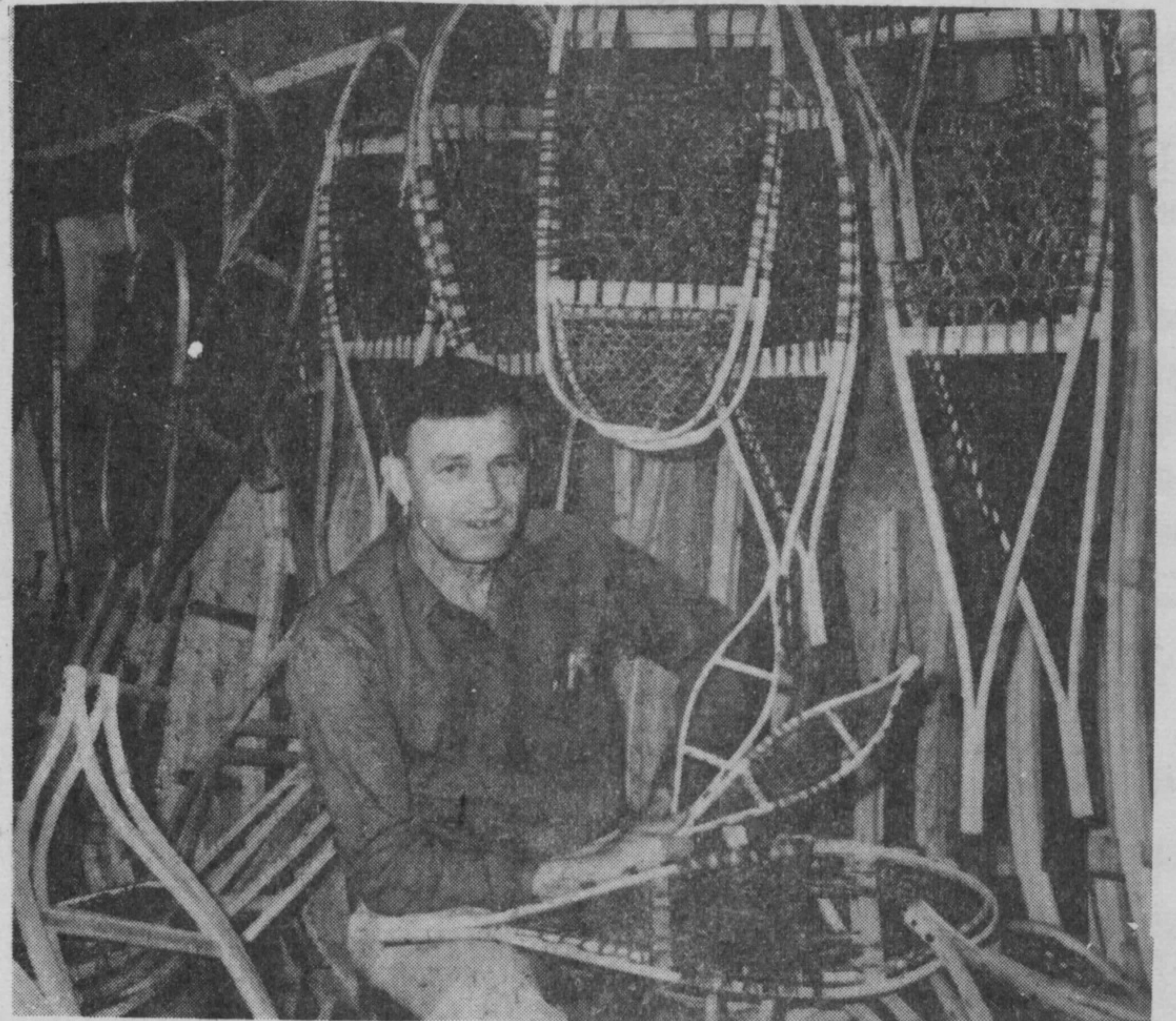


Pictured above are two view of the new premises occupied by Terrace Bay Public Library. The larger quarters were formerly used as a 'games room'. Photos by L. Niiranen
