agreed to pay Fifty Dollars for Midget Hockey.

The appointment of W. Farrell as Bush Fire Chairman was confirmed on a motion by Council.

One price was submitted to Council on landscaping for the Swimming Pool area. This was left over to a future meeting. The Reeve requested Mr. Strutt to look into the curfew.

Samples of plastic and aluminum sheeting were inspected and discussed for the wind-break at the swimming pool. Council agreed they would carry capital costs of recreation, receiving recommendation from the Recreation Committee. This item was therefore deducted from their Recreation Budget.

The Reeve reported repairs to the sewer on Kenogami had been completed as requested. Councillor Cavanaugh discussed the problem of water run-off on Lakeview if no curbing is installed. The Reeve felt some adequate solution to trench the roadway would maintain the lawns.

A short discussion of the Centennial Project contest which would be sponsored by the Chamber of Commerce, was held, the amount established at Six Thousand Dollars or more.

A motion by Councillor Cavanaugh for remuneration was again shelved to a later meeting. A Budget meeting was scheduled for Council on Tuesday, May 19th at 4.30 P.M.
