The first phase will be ready for opening July 1,1967.

The concept of Ontario's centennial project and the site have been discussed with Metro Chairman Wm. Allan and have been endorsed by him, Mr.Robarts said. The executive of the Metropolitan Conservation Authority have also endorsed both concept and site in principle, he added.

The announcement is the culmination of studies which have been conducted by the Ontario Government since September, 1963. The selection of a site has been particularly difficult, as can be seen from the scope of the project.

Construction of the Centennial phase will start in July, 1965 and completed Sept. 1966, so that the centre can be open July 1, 1967.
