QUEBEC PROPERTY PURCHASE ANNOUNCED

"Mr. G.L. Carruthers, President, announces the purchase by Kimberly-Clark of Canada Limited of property in the new industrial park of the city of Jacques Cartier, Quebec.

"Situated on the south shore of the St. Lawrence, these 27 acres of land are on the Trans-Canada Highway and readily accessible to the new bridge and tunnel route to Montreal currently under construction.

"If present plans materialize, a product distribution centre will eventually be established on this site to serve the expanding market for the Company's nationally-advertised facial tissues, feminine sanitary napkins, toilet tissues, etc."
