





Councillor Cavanaugh reported the School Nurse would be starting audiometer testing and wished a program from Council. Council felt this program should be established by the M.O.H.

A motion of congratulations was offered by Councillor Cavanaugh for the Chamber of Commerce who, through their lengthy efforts, had secured vastly improved radio reception for Terrace Bay. The long-awaited low power transmitter has been installed and could be tuned in at 1010.

Councillor Cavanaugh had completed his summary of job responsibilities but would retain them to include the proposed amalgamation of the Polic and Fire Department.
