POLICE DEFINE MEANING OF "PRIVATE ROAD"

The Terrace Bay Police Department recently asked the Crown Attorney for a definition of "private roads" in or adjacent to the township and what charges, if any, can be laid by them when accidents occur on said roads.

The reply stated that under sub-section 10 of Section 1 of the Highway Traffic Act "Highway" includes a common and public highway, street, avenue, parkway, driveway, square, place, bridge, viaduct or trestle, designed and intended for, or used by, the general public for the passage of vehicles."

Anyone breaking any of the laws provided by the Highway Traffic Act are therefore subject to the same laws when travelling on any of the roads adjacent to the township.

It should be noted that when a proposed candidate is not present at the nomination meeting, his nomination paper will not be valid unless there is any evidence satisfactory to the returning officer that the proposed candidate consents to be so nominated.

NOTICE TO VOTERS

By-law No.133 of the Township of Terrace Bay reads as follows:- "No person whose name appears on the defaulters list, provided for by Section 104 of the Municipal Act, shall be entitled to vote at a Municipal Election in respect of real property unless at the time of tendering his vote he produces and leaves with the Deputy Returning Officer the certificate from the Treasurer or the Collector, showing that the taxes in respect of which the default was made have since been paid."
