the Department of Lands and Forests, with copies to the Hon. George Wardrope, M.P., Department of Finance, and Department of Public Works in which the Town Council strongly urged a decision on the undeveloped property they hold on Lakeview Drive.

W. Farrell forwarded a list of Bush Fire Equipment to be purchased amounting to \$2,600. A motion by Council authorized the purchase of a new fog machine at an approximate cost of \$2,000.

Two letters signed by W. Megraw, M. Simmer, H. Coe, J. Shivas, F. Sutherland, A. Chisholm and A. Chadney were read by Reeve Adamo to Council. The last letter received inferred Council members were not kept fully aware of the actions of their leader. Reeve Adamo pointed out all members of Council were fully aware of this correspondence, though, being addressed to himself and not Council, it had not been read at a Council meeting. He then read the first letter which questioned as ill-advised, the use of the taxpayers money in making a grant towards the purchase of Ceremonial Swords for the local Sea Cadet Corps. He was assured by Council members present they had been in agreement in making this grant. Reeve Adamo congratulated this group for their keen interest in the taxpayer's money, but considered it money well spent in the interests of the town's youth. He credited the Sea Cadet Corps with the reduction in any juvenile problem the Town had previously. Reeve Adamo further explained the other organizations mentioned in the first letter made use of the Recreation facilities whereas the Sea Cadet Corps did not. He reiterated the fact that Council Chambers were open to the public.

The By-Law naming the new Roads Superintendent was held pending a discussion between the Reeve and Mr. J.

Wellings. Council passed a motion allotting reimbursement to Reeve Adamo when he attended the Municipal League Convention in Port Arthur.

David A. Whitley was duly appointed a Constable in the Township of Terrace Bay. Councillor Brown stated Constable Whiteley would arrive from Toronto on April 28th.

A request from the Aguasabon Golf Course to supply an outlet for connection of their water supply was agreed to and Reeve Adamo stated a blueprint must be submitted for their proposed turnover of property.

On a query by Councillor Cavanaugh, he was informed the Townsite Crew had investigated the flooding conditions on Department of Highway property adjacent to the Station road, and had made recommendation. Councillor Cavanaugh reminded members of the Centennial project meeting in Marathon on May 7. Some representatives of or ganizations in

town would be attending and he intended to be present himself.

Councillor Brown felt Council should institute their usual spring clean-up drive. He discussed with Council the costly repairs necessary to the street sweeper. Councillor Fraser felt it to be a matter for the Police, if no action were taken on correcting the hazardous unloading practice at the Liquor Store.

Discussing the new storage area, it was felt advisable to have a direct line into the Guard Station in order (Continued P.5)

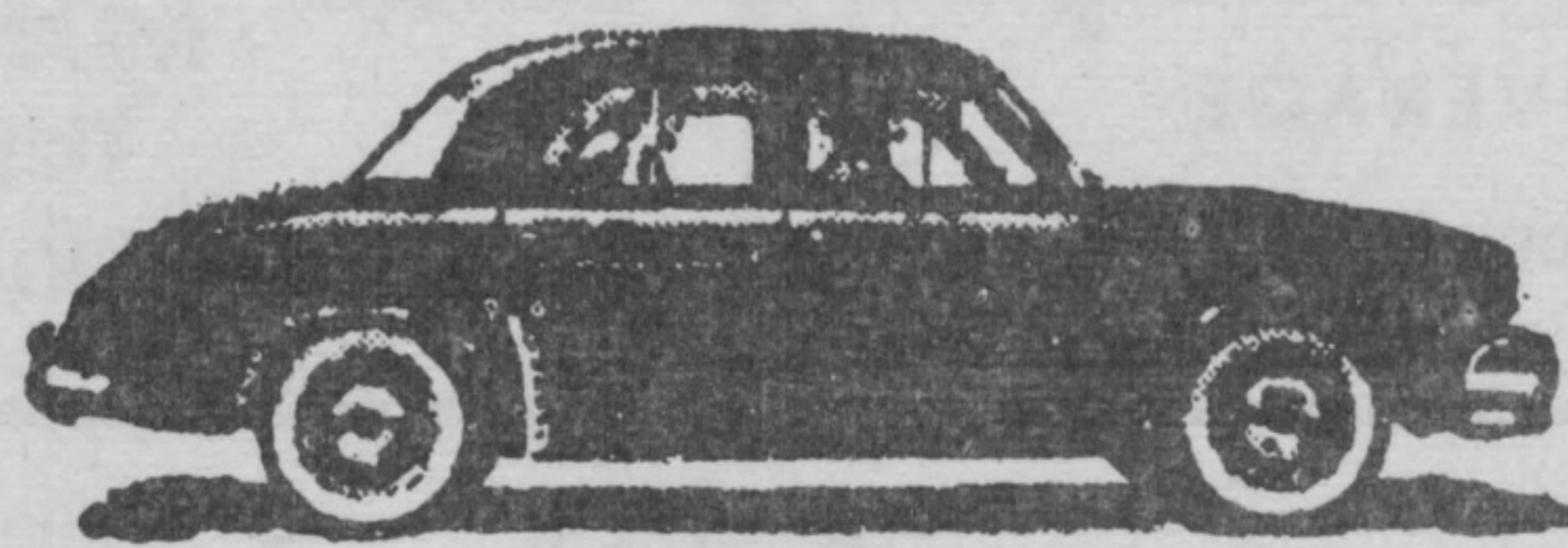
