The name of Rev. T. Garnett Husser was inadvertently omitted from the write-up on Rev. Cano's 25th anniversary.

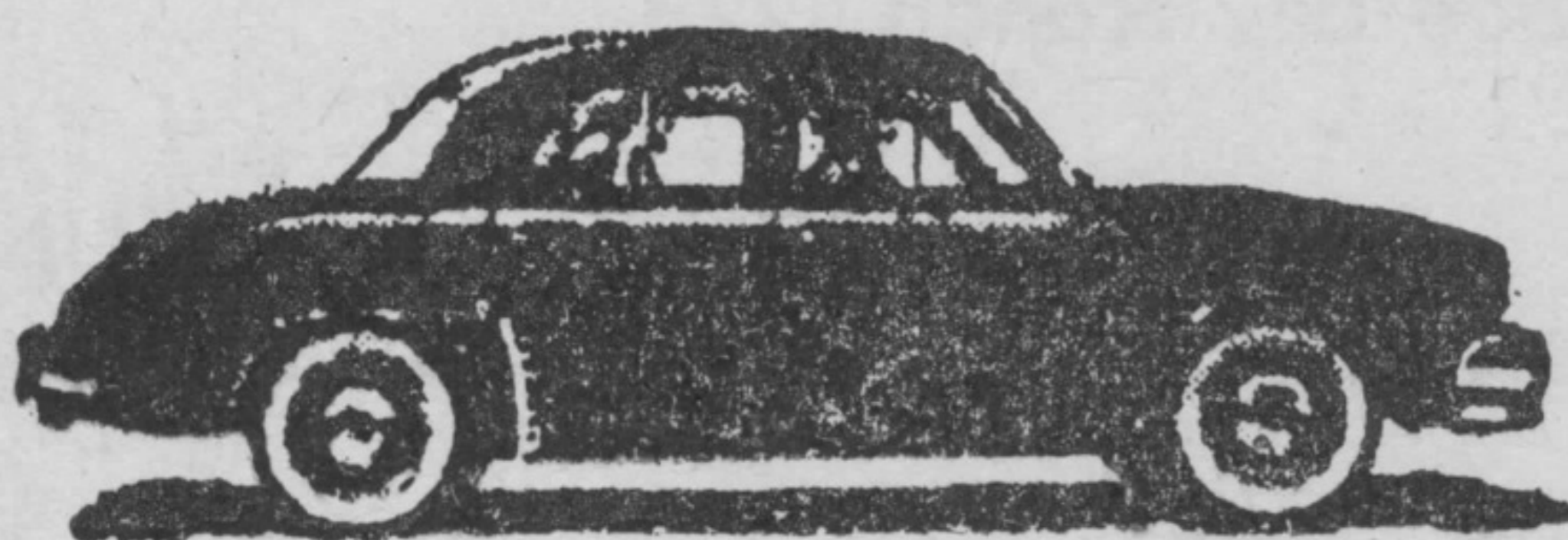
