togs. A definition of bathing togs would be - swim apparel, towels, bathing caps and beach jackets. I understand that the weather conditions are not the warmest here at times, however, when it concerns the matter of safety and sanitation, this ruling must be enforced. There is no other swimming pool in Ontario that permits swimmers to bring any clothing on deck other than bathing togs. For the people who insinuated that the swimming pools in Marathon and Red Rock permit their swimmers on deck with clothing is totally false. Their ruling is much stricter than ours. The question of water temperature in our swimming pool. The temperature has never this year been lower than 70 degrees farenheit and we maintain to hold a temperature between 70 degrees and 78 degrees farenheit at all times.

**Golf News**

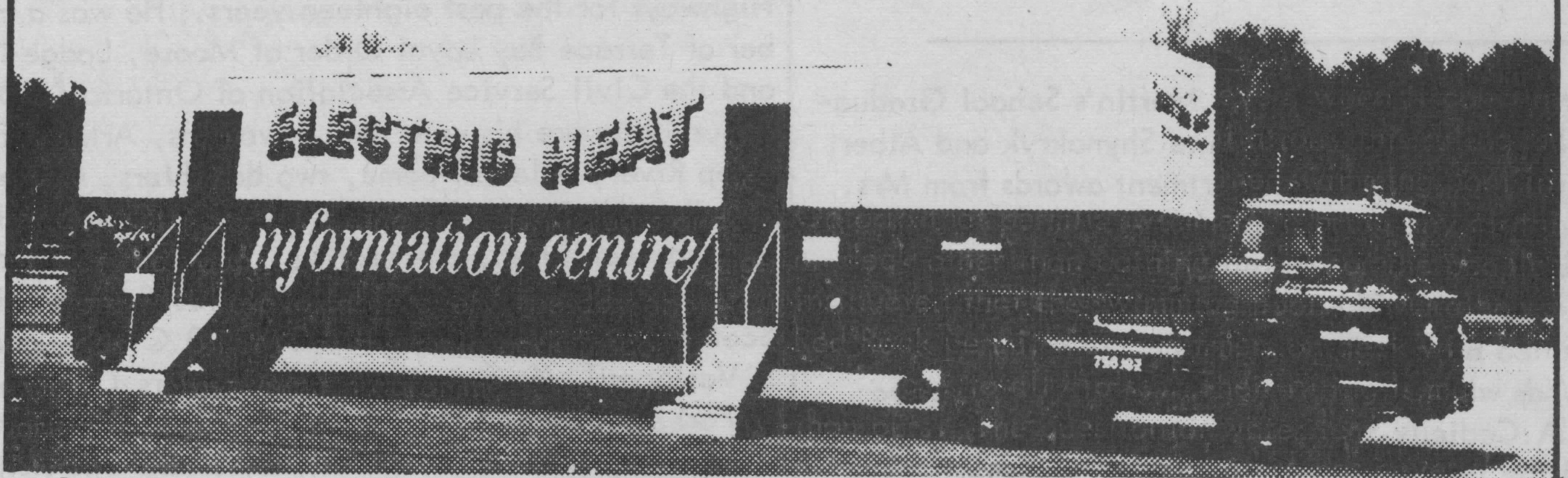
Not quite two years in operation and the Aquasabon Golf Course is emerging from it's shell and making itself known in the various tournaments in the district.
