NEWSPAPER CONVENTION ON NEXT WEEK

Canada's biggest newspaper convention, the annual assembly of the Canadian Weekly Newspapers Association opens Wednesday, August 18 at MacDonald Hotel in Edmonton.

More than 300 weekly newspaper editors and publishers, many with their wives and families along, are expected to attend the three-day convention.

The convention will have a Klondike Days theme and non-business items on the agenda include a Klondike party and outdoor barbecue.

Main business item will be the proposed joining of Canadian Community Newspapers Representatives, the weekly advertising sales organization with the CWNA.

OPEN SEASON FOR GROUSE

Hon. A. Kelso Roberts, Minister of Lands and Forests has announced the open seasons for 1965 for ptarmigan, ruffed grouse, sharptailed grouse and spruce grouse.

Seasons and bag limits are very similar to those in effect in 1964, with minor changes in eastern

Ontario counties.

The season will be, for this district, September 25 to December 15. Bag and possession limits are 5 per day - possession limit 15 in the aggregate.

SUMMER COTTAGE LANDS IN ONTARIO

To obtain a Crown land summer cottage site in Ontario the following procedure should be followed:

1. Select the general area in which you are interested.
2. Write or visit the district office under which this area is administered to determine location and cost of available Crown land.
3. Visit area to select location.
4. Make application and payment to district office for your selected lot.
5. On receipt of approval from the District Forester you may commence building cottage.
6. When cottage is completed, apply to district office for patent (original Deed from Crown) to land.

Lots vary from 1/2 acres to two acres and in width from 100 ft. to 200 ft. Islands between 1/2 acre and three acres in area may be purchased in their entirety.

The charge for land for private summer cottage purposes which is already surveyed is: 1. Regular area - \$400 or \$150 and \$2.50 a ft. lakeshore frontage, whichever is the greater. 2. Irregular area - \$650 or \$150 and \$2.50 a ft. lakeshore frontage up to and including 200 ft. and \$1 a ft. frontage for each foot in excess of 200 ft. whichever is the greater. Islands \$500 or \$150 and \$350 for each acre, whichever is the greater.
