Terrace Bay students returned to school on Tuesday morning with, it seemed to observers, enthusiasm. After being segregated to their various home areas for two months seeing them congregated on the school lots Tuesday morning reminded us forcibly that this is a young town with many children crossing the streets to get to the different schools. Parents are urged to instil safe pedestrian habits in the younger children and motorists are asked to be on the alert at times when the students are going to and leaving schools.

James returns to the Grade six pupils, Mr. Jim Davey of Port Arthur will instruct in Grade Seven and Principal Mr. Don Briscoe will take Grade eight with Mrs. Shirley Mikus supplying.

Kenney welcomes Mrs. Lois Gunn of Sudbury to teach Grade one in St. Martin's Separate School, and is pleased to have the following teachers return: Miss Joyce Raper of Toronto, in Kindergarten, Miss Lois MacKay of Marathon for Grade two, who spent her summer taking a course in Primary Methods Part Two in Ottawa, Mrs. Yolande Rajotte Grade three, Mr. Joe Carty of Grade four took a course in Physical Education part two, in Hamilton last summer, Mr. Ed McAdam takes a split class of Grades five and six, Mr. John Bird takes grades six and seven and reports spending his summer in Toronto where he took a music course, and Mr. Kenney instructs in Grade eight. Mrs. Lois Shubaly will be Principal supply.
