But why wait for the fire fighter? Check these hazards yourself. Or call the fire chief and make an appointment.



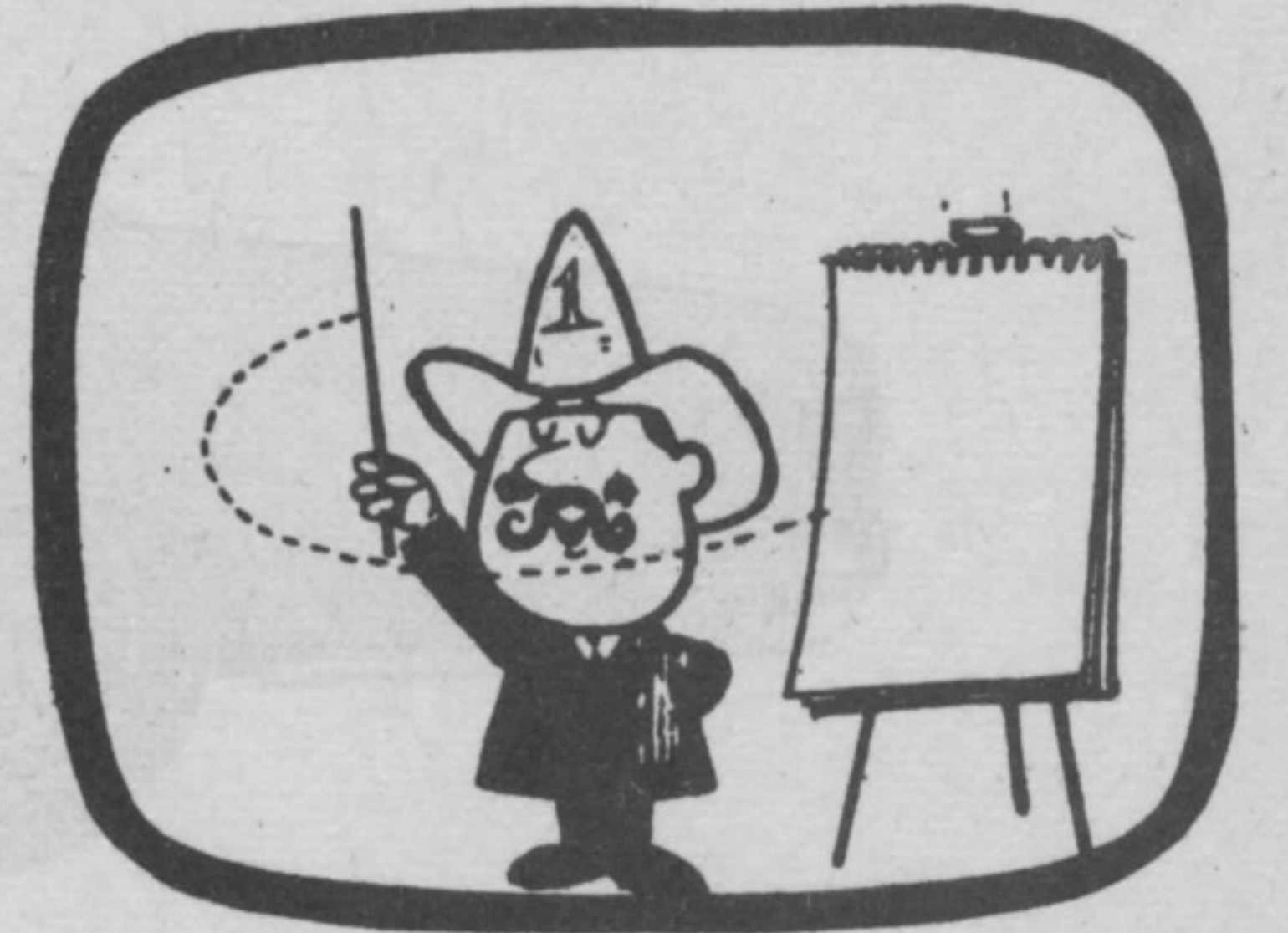
