THIRTY-TWO RINKS IN MOOSE BONSPIEL

The Loyal Order of Moose, No. 1752 were hosts last weekend to thirty-two rinks from out of town who participated in the men's bonspiel. Teams came from Port Arthur, Fort William, Schreiber, Atikokan, Beardmore, Marathon and Sioux Lookout. The bonspiel got underway Friday evening at 6 p.m. when Piper F. Sutherland led the teams onto the ice. Councillor Ken MacLeod threw the first rock.

A banquet, convened by Mrs. A. Didura, was held on Saturday evening at the Moose Hall with the Women of the Moose serving.

Winners of the first event were the Bill Carty rink of Fort William with Vern Walker, third, Len Victor second and John Gilles, lead. They were presented with the Moose Trophy and miniatures by Terrace Bay Governor of the Moose, M. Didura, and they also received seventeen jewel Gruen wrist watches. Runner up was the Tom Latour rink of Terrace Bay with Vern Hopper, Roy Larson and Ralph Cole. They received pocket transistor radios. Winner of the second event was the Ken Johnson rink of Terrace Bay with Emile Bouchie, Scotty Hamilton and Ron Dakin. They received mantel transistor radios. Runner-up in this event was the

Frank Perozak rink of Fort William with Al Stecky, G. Glowacki and Hal Boresky. They won electric soldering guns. The third event was taken by the Al Bronski rink of Atikokan with Pat Reilly, Mike Shmyr and Fern Perren. They received plaid sport shirts. Runner-up was the O. Santala rink from Beardmore with M. Hallin, H. Hallin and S. Anderson. They received sock, tie sets, tie bars and cuff links.
