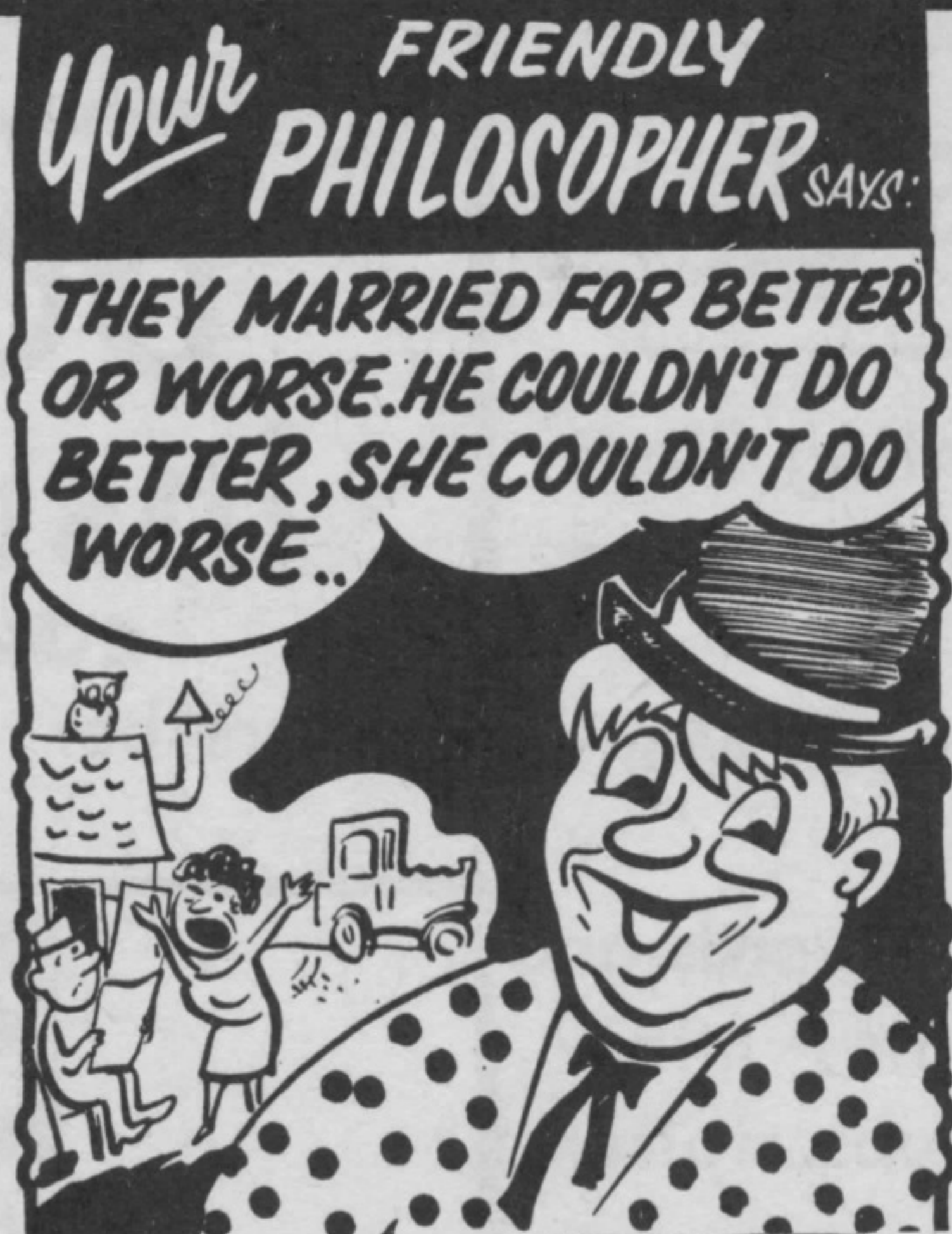

Following the business meeting a delightful lunch was served by Mrs.Mary Bougeron and Mrs.Hilda Hiebert.

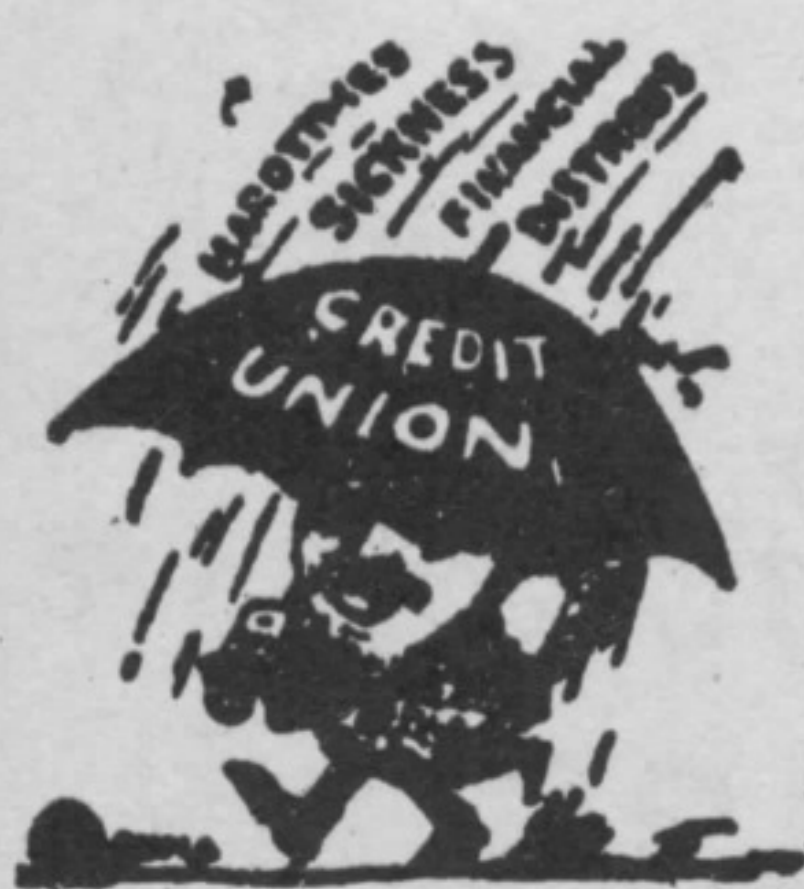
CATHOLIC GIRLS" CLUB MEETS
