Mr. and Mrs. H. Sargent of Toronto spent the weekend at their camp on Nicol Island and announced that the property is for sale.

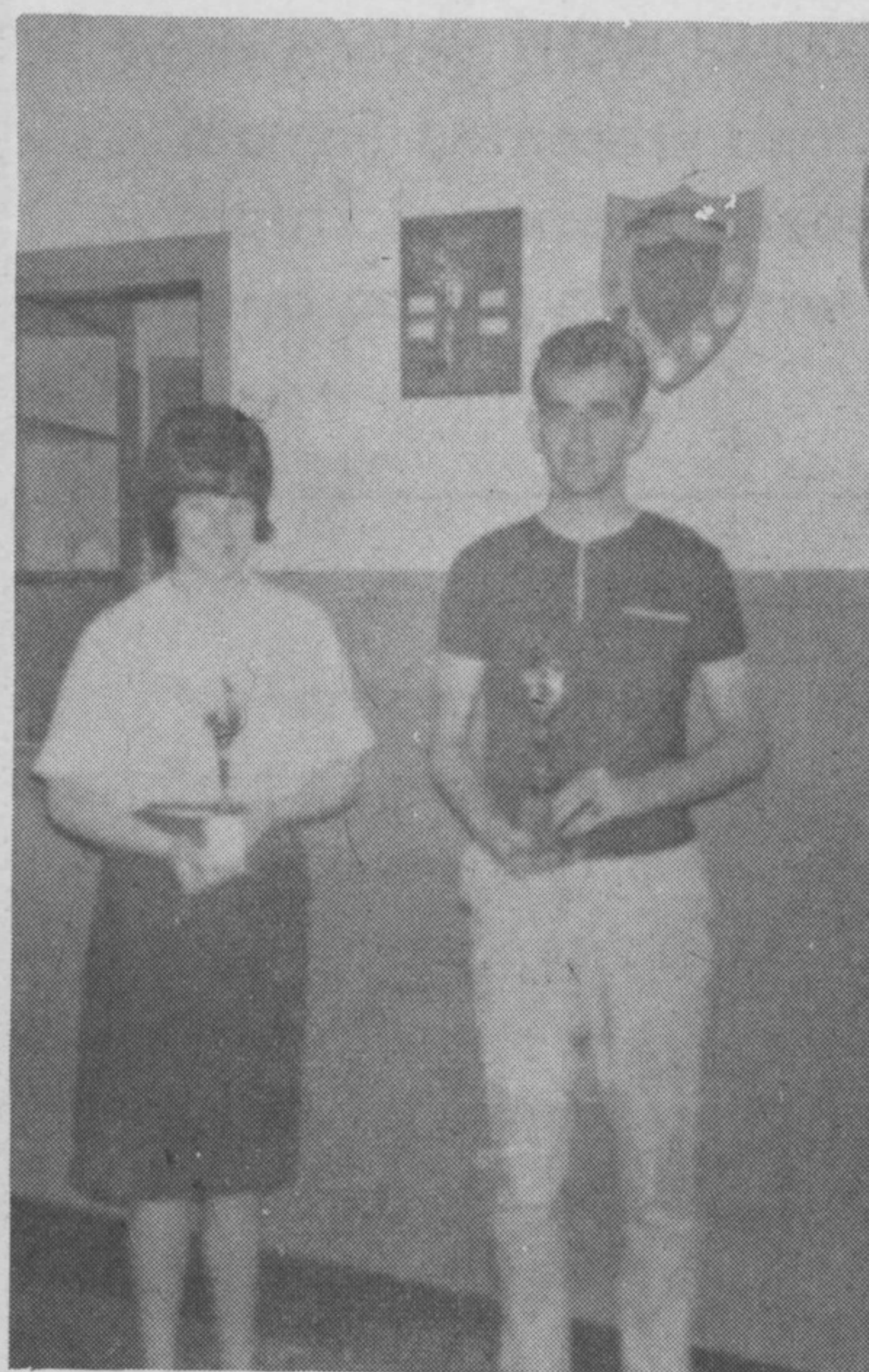
Mrs. M. Yandon of Noranda will be Chef at Rosspport Inn for the summer.
