



# Two weeks' vacation with pay

The Ontario Department of Labour on July 1, 1966, will extend vacation pay benefits to all full time, and regular part time, employees in the Province's general and construction industry. You will be entitled to:

- at least one week's vacation with pay each year for the first three years of employment, payment to be on the basis of at least 2% of your pay for all work done during the vacation year, and
- when you have completed 36 months of continuous or non-continuous employment with the same employer you will be entitled to two weeks' vacation with pay. Payment

will be on the basis of at least 4% of your pay for all work done during the vacation year. How does the plan work?

An employee having four years continuous or non-continuous employment as of July 1, 1966 will qualify for two weeks' vacation with pay providing the employee has not already taken a paid vacation during his fourth year of employment.

An employee commencing work on or after July 1st, 1966, will be entitled to one weeks' paid vacation in 1967-68-69. In 1970 the employee would be entitled to two weeks' vacation with pay.

Only employees in the construction industry will be required to use the vacation stamp and stamp book method of payment.

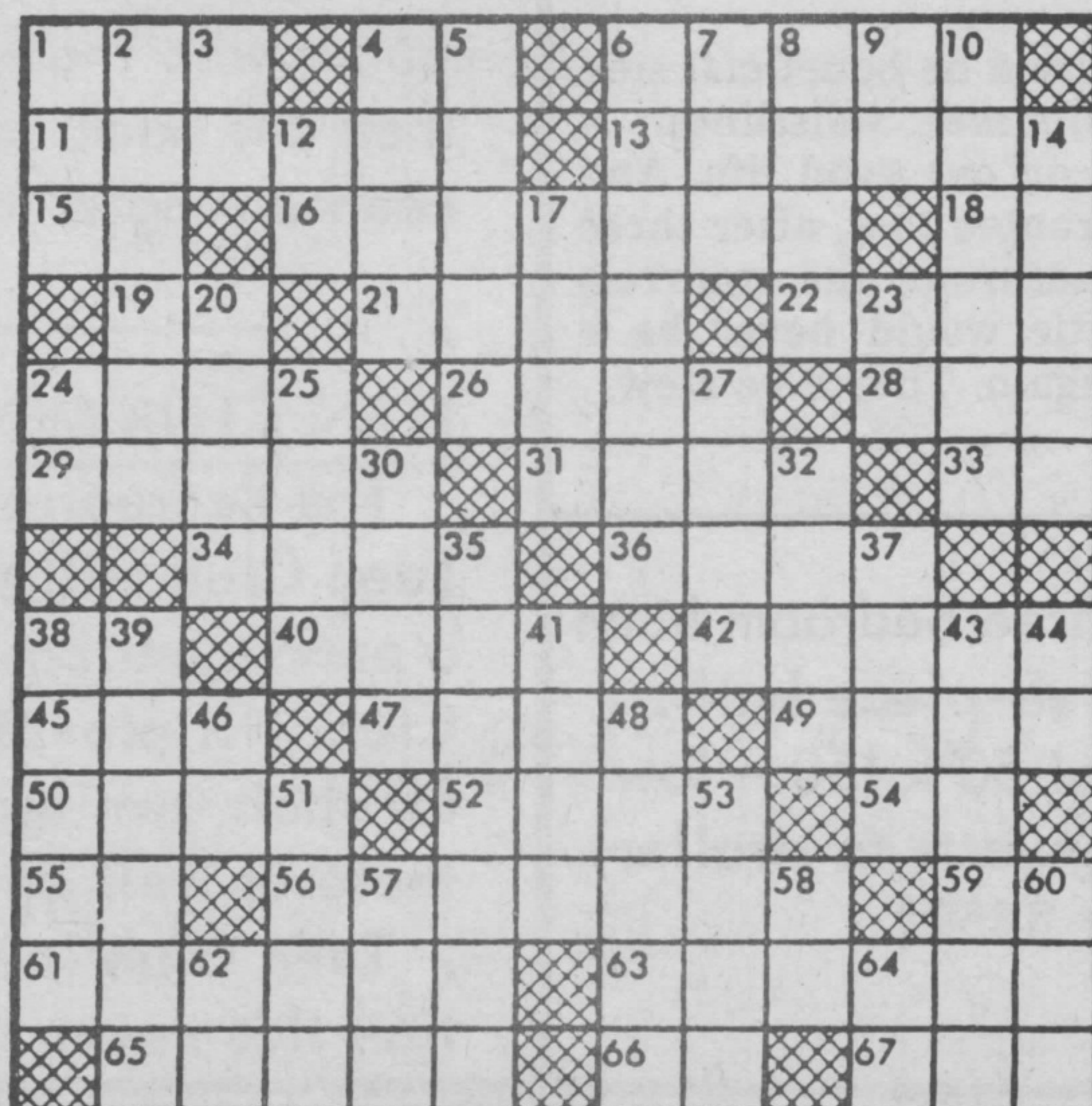

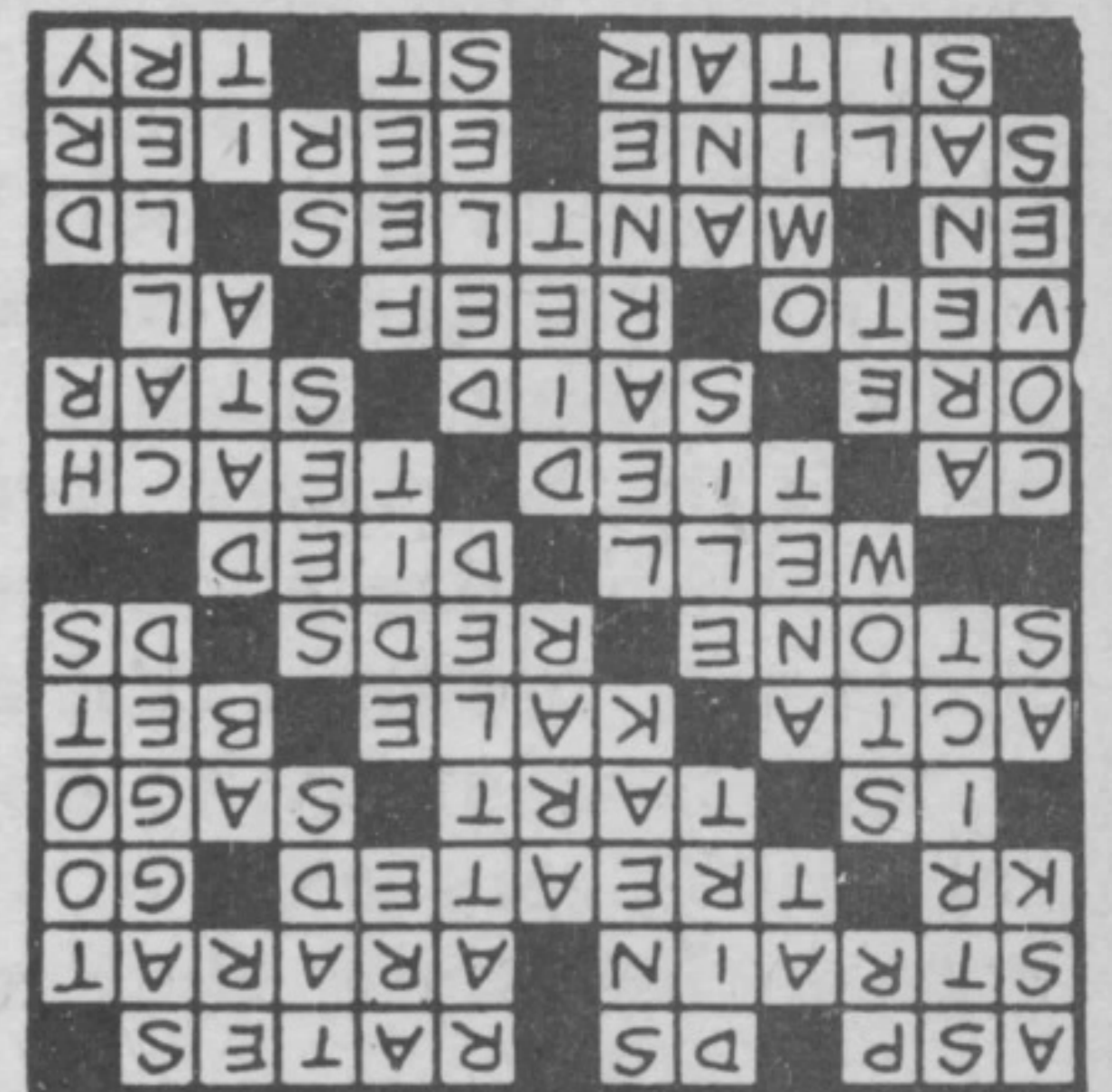
