

CENTENNIAL CARAVAN HERE NEXT YEAR

The first of eight Confederation Caravans that will bring historical exhibits to about 700 cities, towns and villages across Canada during Centennial Year has passed its initial trial run with flying colors.

Number four of the eight Confederation Caravans will start out on May 1st and will reach Terrace Bay on Saturday, October 7th next year.

Total exhibition area to be covered by a full caravan, when in quadrangle position on a given site, will be about 40,000 square feet.
