All parents are cordially invited to attend and support the Teens.

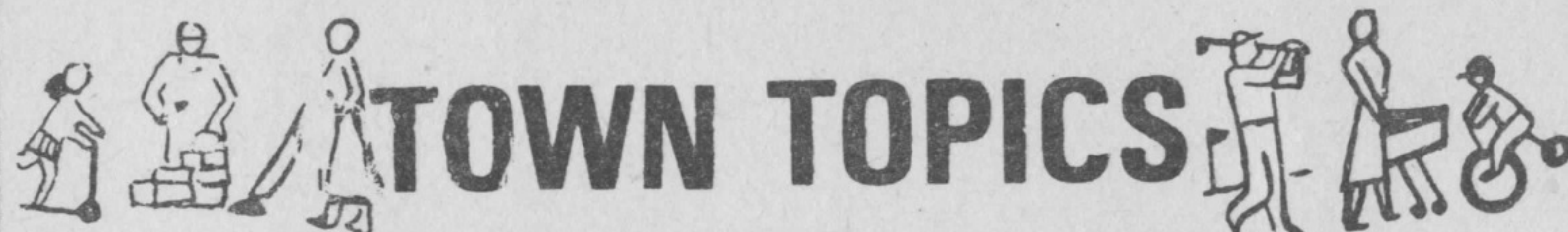
JUNIOR HOCKEY MEETING SEPTEMBER 14TH
