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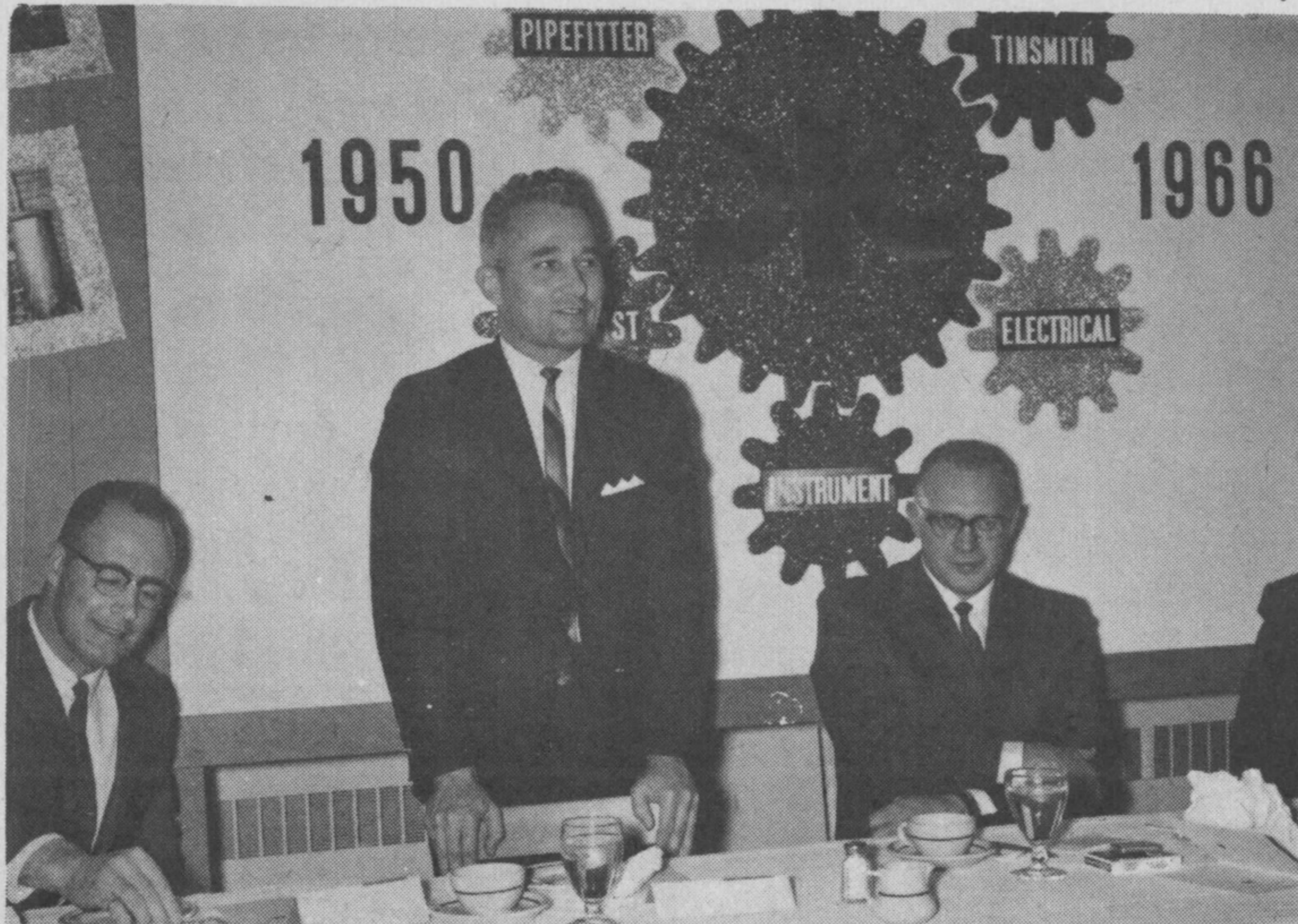
TRADES GRADUATES (Cont'd from page 10)

Guest speaker, Mr. John T. Koski, Principal of the Northern Ontario Institute of Technology, Kirland Lake, was introduced by Mr. W. Farrell.

Mr. Koski spoke on the development and changes in the Ontario secondary and university educational system that has been made in order to meet the demand for skilled tradesmen, technicians, and technologists. 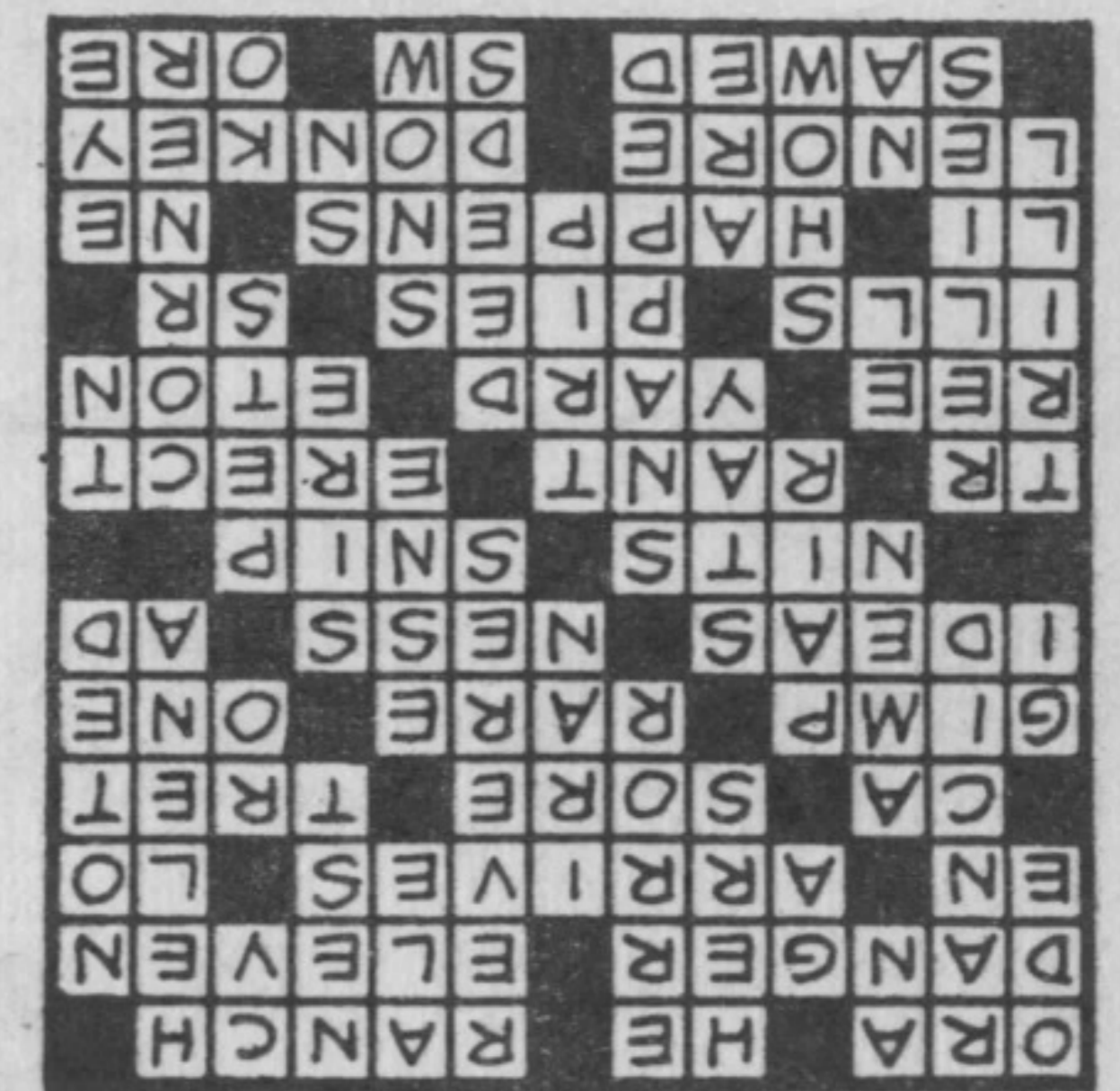

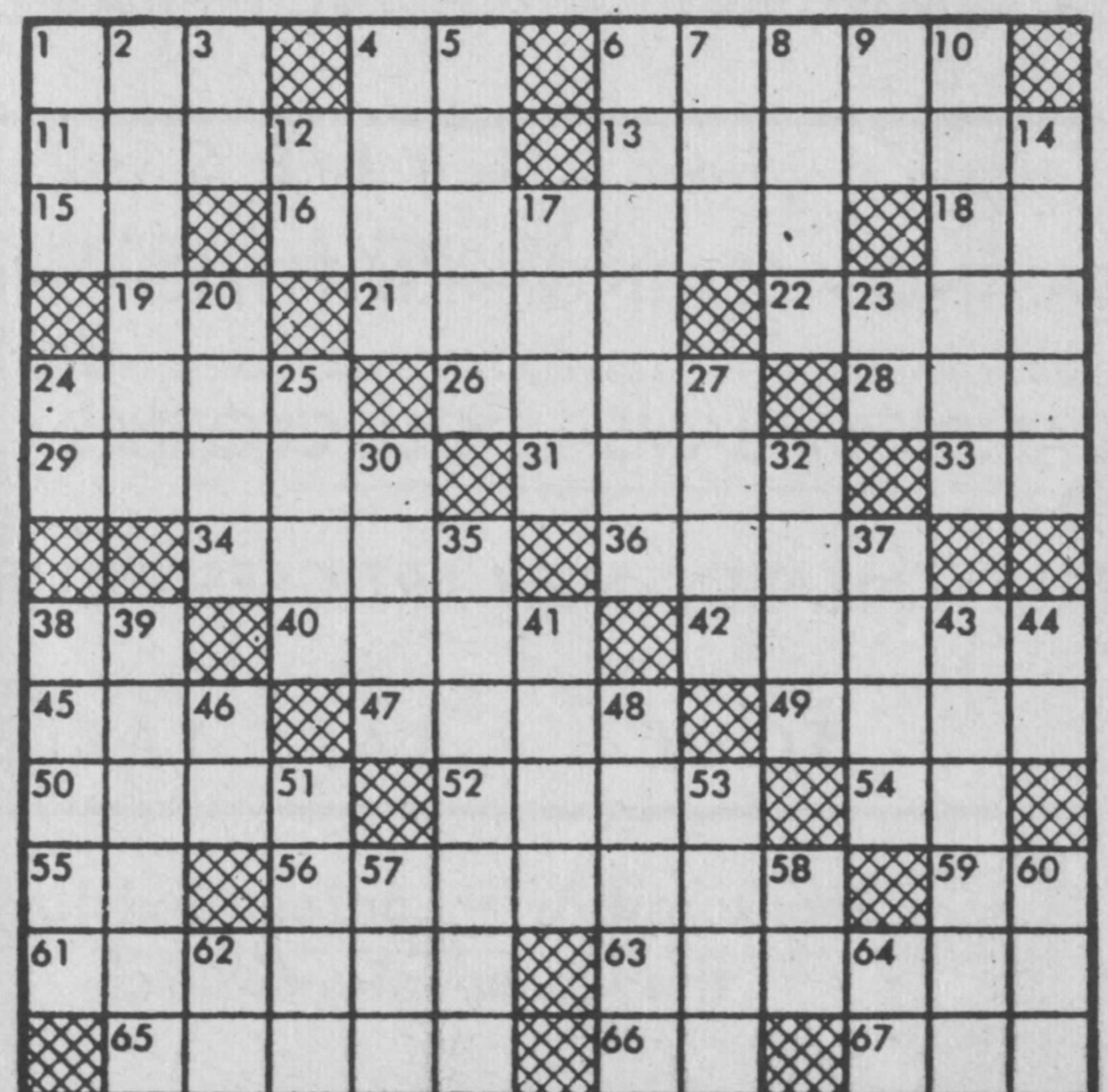
