RE: SNOW REMOVAL - TOWNSHIP ROADS

By-Law #51C of the Township of Terrace Bay provides as follows:

Section 89 - H.T.A.

Sub. Sec. #9 "Notwithstanding the other provisions of this section, no person shall park or leave standing any vehicle whether attended or unattended on a highway in such a manner as to interfere with the movement of other traffic or the clearing of snow from the highway."

Sub. Sec. #II "A constable or an officer appointed for the carrying out of the provisions of this Act, upon discovery of any vehicle parked or left in contravention of subsection 9 or of a municipal bylaw, may cause it to be moved or taken to and placed or stored in a suitable place and all costs and charges for removing, care and storage thereof, if; any, are a lien upon the vehicle, which may be enforced in the manner provided by section 48 of The Mechanics' Lien Act, R.S.O. 1950."

Persons are reminded that Kimberly-Clark Pulp and Paper Company snow removal equipment will be in operation during snow storms between the hours of 12.00 midnight to 8.00 a.m. Vehicles left on Township streets after 1.00 a.m. during such operations will be subject to the above Highway Traffic Act regulations.

Penalties are provided for an infraction of this By-Law.


In any event, be it curling or shuffle board, a big social, first of the year, is scheduled for Saturday, November 19.
