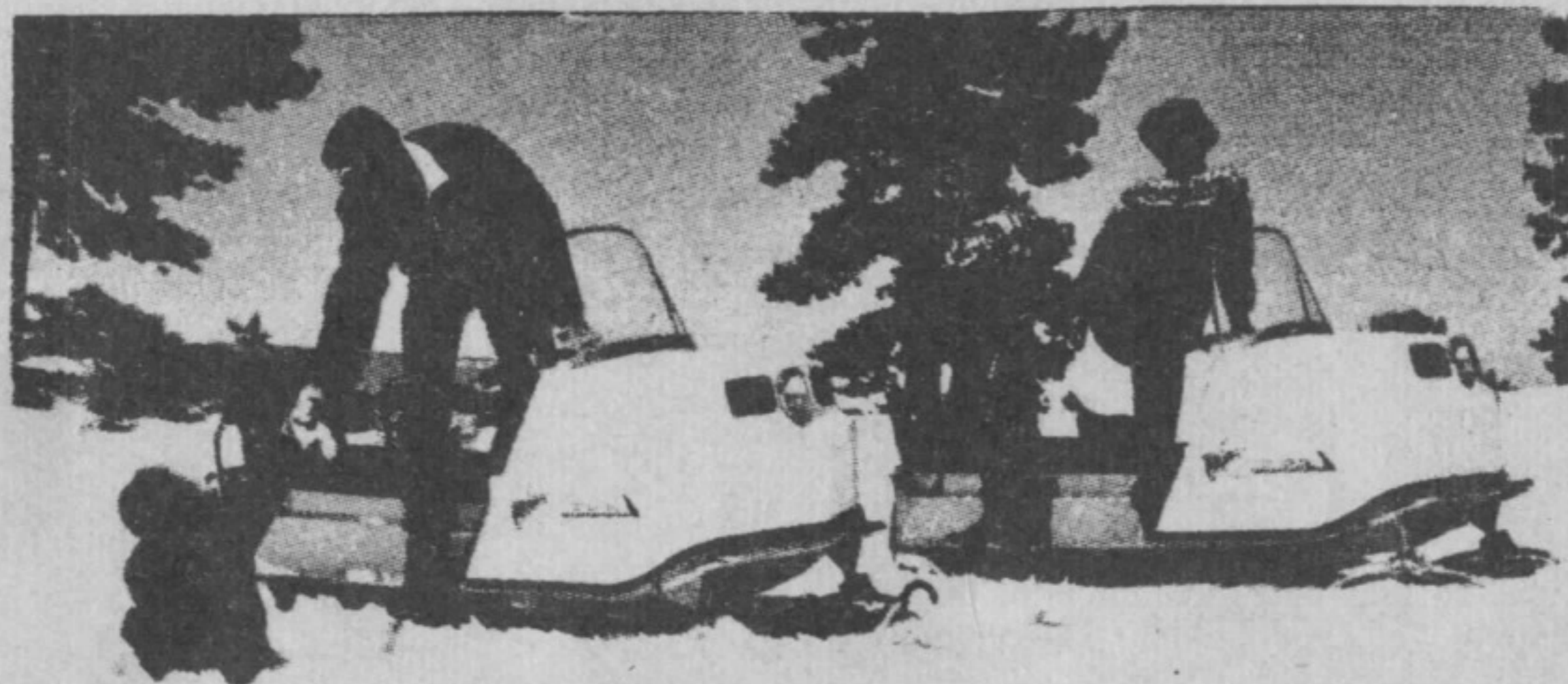

I also feel, Gentlemen, that I would be remiss in my duty if I did not mention and commend the hard and conscientious two years endeavour ex-Reeve Willy Adamo gave to this community.

Naturally in taking over the Reeve's chair, I do have a deep feeling of humility and profound thanks to our citizens for their confidence in me, but by the same token, I am looking forward with excitement and great expectations to the challenge of projects and improvements I can visualize for the benefit of our town.

May I say, Gentlemen, in all seriousness that I do feel extremely lucky to have as my Council this year, such a fine body of citizens and look

forward to a year of co-operation and accomplishment.

In our excitement and expectations of the moment we must realize that we have a long two years ahead. I must warn you that there will be debates, frustration and possibly disagreement but I am sure we are all big enough to leave what transpires in this room between these walls.

You have before you the committees for your term of office. I exhort you to familiarize yourself with your area.

I must point out at this time that as our employees should know their jobs better than we Councilmen, it behooves us then to co-operate in every way possible.

It will be your duty then to keep a watchful eye on your Department, to communicate with the head of that Department only, to listen to complaints when requested and submit monthly reports.

All important decisions such as reprimands, etc. must be decided by Council as a whole.

You have before you the most important projects we will have to deal with. Some of them we certainly will not be able to complete this year but I think it is important that we at least get a start on most of them, keeping in mind a two year deadline.
