Membership in the Association of Municipal Electrical Utilities was authorized.

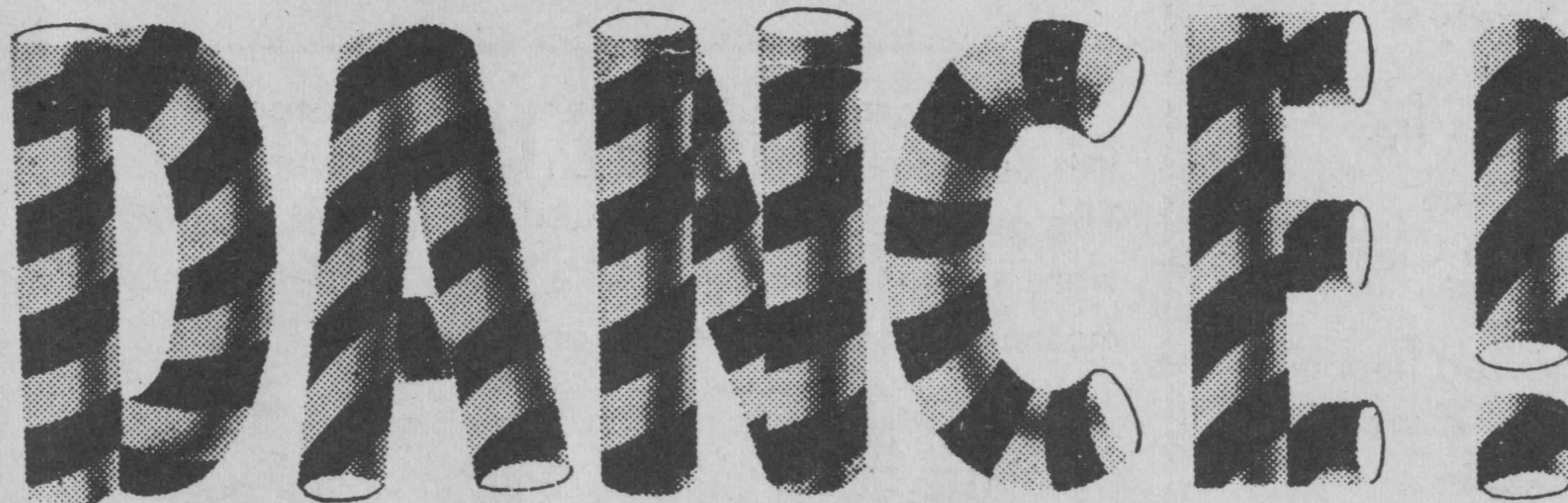
A By-Law was requested for the Minister of Municipal Affairs to appoint a District Assessor. This was given final approval.
