During a social hour and lunch, Mrs. D. Thompson received her Brownie cup and saucer marking her 5th year as Brown Guider.

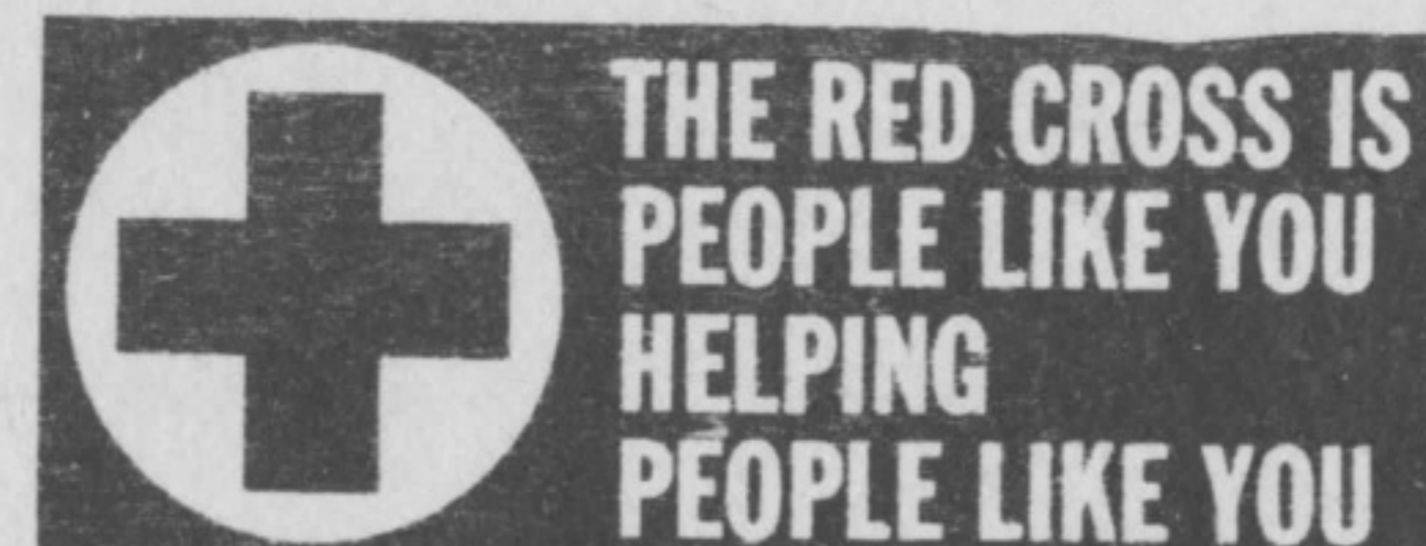
Both Brown and Blue Guiders will attend the training session to be held in Marathon March 18th. Baby sitting and transportation expenses will be paid by the Association.
