Cookbooks are still available. Those who wish copies can contact Mrs. Doreen Kurylo.


Donations of books, magazine, pocket books will be accepted for the Seaman's Club at the Lakehead. A box for this purpose is in the church basement.

Lunch donations were requested for about forty playground billets, the evening of June 21st.


