The Terrace Bay High School Board has contracted with Mr. G. Pearen of Terrace Bay, Ontario, for the transportation of resident students, who will be attending Schreiber High School, during the school year 1967-68.

DEPARTURE TIMES - Leave Terrace Bay at 8:30 a.m.
Leave Schreiber approximately 10 minutes after school closing.

Students will be picked up at the Recreation Centre in the morning and taken directly to Schreiber High School. For return trip, students will be picked up at Schreiber High School and dropped off in front of the Fire Hall. No other stops shall be made to pick up or let students off. Transportation will leave promptly at stated times. Late students will be left behind. Students shall not be permitted to drive vehicle under any circumstances.

The bus driver has full authority to refuse transportation to any student, who does not conduct himself in a proper manner while on the bus.

MILL CORNER STILL HAZARDOUS
