

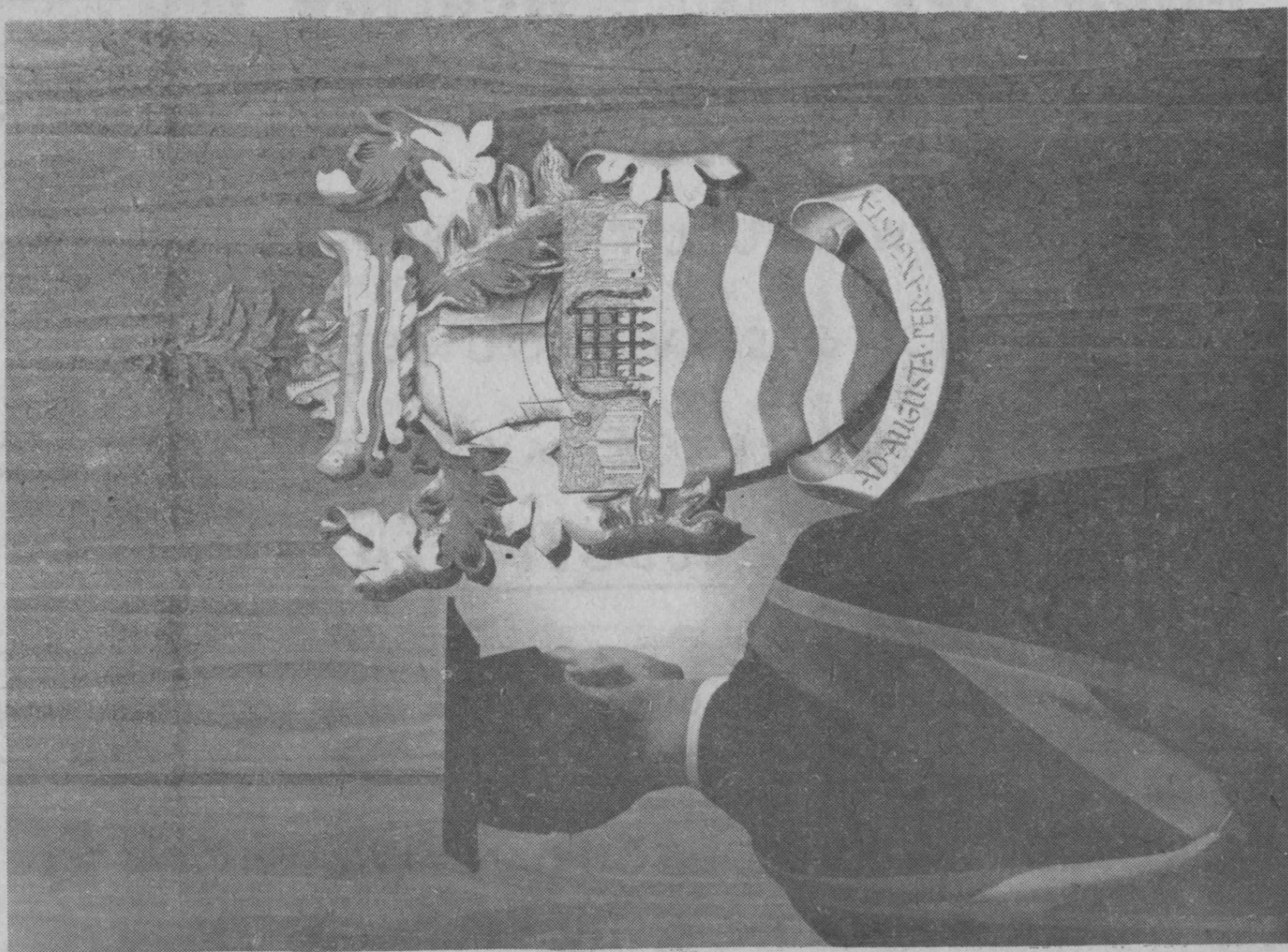
LAKEHEAD UNIVERSITY

**announces schedule of new
programs, fees for 1967-68
academic year**

Lakehead University's recent announcement of programs leading to a Master of Arts and Master of Science degree will be initiated this fall when classes resume on September 18. A new natural science program combining arts and science courses will be started in the Faculty of Science and two new programs, Business Computer Diploma and Forest Research Technology Certificate will be started in the University Schools Division, as well students will be able to major in Russian, Spanish and German in the regular Bachelor of Arts program. Honors programs have also been approved by the University Senate in geology and English-Latin.

These programs are in addition to the more than 300 courses now available at the University leading to general B.A. and B. Sc. degrees, Honors B.A. and Honors B.Sc., M.A. and M. Sc. as well as the overall program in University Schools. Many new subjects are also being offered this year in most of the humanities, social sciences and natural sciences

Master's Program

Master's Degrees will be offered in English, Mathematics, Physics, and Clinical

1. Natural Science

Any student with regular university entrance requirements may apply for this new program for a General B.Sc. The program consists of a minimum of eight science courses and seven arts courses and is designed for students who wish to be elementary teachers in general

2. Computer Technology Diploma

Admission requirements for this program are the same as requirements for the Business Administration Diploma. It is a three-year diploma program which will train students to be compu-

3. Forest Research Technology Diploma

Entrance requirements for this program is the completion of the two-year forest technology diploma program.
